Re: Interview with Christopher Morris, Gary Morris (Natural Father of Chris) and Attorney John Richilano.

DETAILS:

1. On April 20, 1999 Investigators Vette and Acierno interviewed Christopher Morris along with his attorney and father. At approximately 7:43 P.M. and prior to any questioning Investigator Acierno advised Christopher Morris, his father and attorney of their Miranda rights from a Departmental Advisement form. All stated they understood and agreed to speak with investigators. Christopher Morris and his father both signed the advisement waiver form.

2. Investigator Vette asked Morris to explain what had occurred since he woke up this morning to the time he was brought to the Sheriff's Office. Chris Morris said that when he woke up this morning he was getting ready for bowling class which is held at the AMF Bowling alley located at the intersection of Belleview and Federal Blvd. Chris Morris said that this is his first period Columbine High School class. Morris said class was to be held this week Monday through Thursday although the schedule changes from time to time. Morris said that Eric Harris was to pick him up around 5:50 A.M. although Harris never showed up. Chris Morris said he waited for Harris until around 6:00 A.M. so he drove his own vehicle (1985, red, Dodge, Lancer) to the bowling alley and attended class. Morris said that he likes to get to class early so he can get a good bowling ball and shoes and the bowling lanes are turned on about 6:30 A.M. Chris Morris said Eric Harris never called him saying he wouldn't be picking him up this morning. Morris also said that Dylan Klebold at one time used to pick him up for bowling although hasn't done so for about a year.

Morris said during class he never saw Harris or Klebold and assumed they weren't coming to school. Morris said that he has never seen Dylan Klebold or Eric Harris miss bowling class unless they were sick, but both never missed class together. Chris Morris said that today his bowling teammates were Nate LNU, Eddie Day, Terry Sabe and Mike Pavalonin (all last names phonetically spelled) which are all Columbine High School students. Chris Morris said that each game takes between 15-20 minutes and class is usually done about 7:20 A.M.

3. Following the bowling class Chris said he drove directly to Clement Park and was listening to music and looking for paperwork he needed to bring to class. Chris Morris said that during this time his vehicle overheated. Morris said this was just prior to 8:00 A.M. so he let the car cool down in Clement Park. (Morris later changed his story and said that he drove from the bowling alley to McDonald's to get something to eat, by himself, then responded to the area of Columbine High School where the school kids smoke and ate what he purchased from McDonald's. Morris described this area as being on a street above the student parking lot. Morris said while in this smoking area he spoke to George LNU, Frank LNU and another male individual whose name he couldn't recall. Morris said this conversation only lasted a few minutes while he was eating. Morris said once he finished eating he drove to Clement Park where his car overheated and spoke to another male individual while waiting for his car to cool down. Morris could not remember this person's name.) Chris Morris said once the vehicle cooled down he drove closer to the Columbine High School so he didn't have as far to walk when he left the school. Morris said he then went to his second period Science class with Mr. Freezen (Phonetic) then to his third period Government/Economics class. Chris Morris said following this class he went to his car and drove to Cub Foods where he purchased Mountain Dew and other items, then drove to Cory Freezen's house, (Son of Science Teacher, Mr. Freezen) where Morris said that he hangs out at a lot following school. Chris Morris said once at Cory's house they began playing Nintendo games for approximately thirty minutes to an hour when Cory received a telephone call from his mother saying that there had been a shooting at Columbine High School. Chris Morris said he and Cory

Freezen then attempted to drive to the school and got to Cross Drive near the movie theaters turned around and went to the International House of Pancakes (IHOP) in an attempt to find school friends. Chris Morris said that he and Cory Freezen didn't see anyone so they drove back to Cory Freezen's house which is on the other side (West) of Southwest Plaza. Chris Morris said while on there way back to Cory's house he received several pages on his Motorola pager (303-505-9051) and attempted to return the calls once at Freezen's house. Morris said one of the calls was from his girlfriend, Nichol who said that she was at the IHOP. Morris said that he and Cory then got into Cory's truck since Morris' vehicle was beginning to overheat again and drove back to the IHOP attempting to locate Morris' girlfriend. Morris said that Nichol had already left by the time he and Cory arrived so they drove to Nichol's house and found her there. Chris Morris said once at Nichol's house she told him that she believed one of the people involved in the shooting at Columbine High School was "Dylan" Chris Morris said that he is familiar with Dylan who works with him at Blackjack Pizza and is on his same bowling team. Morris they didn't stay at Nichol's house long because Cory was worried about his dad so they drove back to Freezen's house to wait for telephone calls or any word that Cory's dad was alright. Chris Morris said once back at Cory's house Charles Phillips called saying that he had heard what had happened on the news Morris said that Charles Phillips, his brother, and a neighbor who heard the report on the news and knew Mr Freezen, then came over to Cory Freezen's house Morris said they were all watching the news when they reported that the people involved were wearing trench coats and possibly involved in a group called the trench coat mafia. Chris Morris said he knew the only people wearing trench coats at Columbine High School were Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold, because he stopped wearing his about a year ago and didn't know anyone else other than Harris and Klebold who wore trench coats. Chris Morris said things began sounding familiar and he not only remembered the two wearing trench coats but also remembered that the two had been shooting bowling pins in the mountains. Morris also said that Harris and Klebold had been involved in blowing things up around work and explained that Harris and Klebold both had been in trouble at Blackjack Pizza and were told not to light firecrackers or anything else. Morris said

Harris and Klebold would take the gunpowder out of the firecrackers and compact or pressurize it. Chris Morris said after realizing this, he and Cory Freeze both believed that Harris and Klebold were involved. Morris said he then called 911 in an attempt to speak to a Detective and explain that he believed he knew who the suspects were. Morris said once he called the Sheriff's Office he was being transferred on the telephone and it was disconnected. Morris said that his mother, who works at Cherry Hills Police Department, then paged him so he returned the telephone call and told his mother what had taken place. Chris Morris said that his mother then had him speak to a Cherry Hills Police Detective. Chris Morris said the Cherry Hills detective was to pass on the information to JCSO and didn't remember his name. Chris said he then hung up and decided to again try calling the Sheriff's Office. Chris Morris said he was transferred to a Detective and told the Detective his story. Investigator T. Acierno confirmed this information as he was the Investigator Morris had spoken to when he called the second time. Chris Morris said Investigator Acierno told him to stay at Freeze's residence and the police would come by and talk with him. Morris said the police arrived at Freeze's residence and told him to remove all of his property from his pockets. Morris said he did so and was placed in handcuffs and brought to Clement Park where he was taken to a van where several people questioned him. Morris said following the questioning he was brought to the Sheriff's Office.

4. Chris Morris explained approximately 6 months ago Dylan Klebold brought what Chris believed as a pipe bomb to work. Morris described the pipe bomb which appeared to be approximately 2" round and 12" long with caps at both ends and a fuse. Morris said that he and a number of employees saw the pipe bomb and Morris told Klebold to get it out of the business. Morris said that Klebold mumbled something to the effect that you put shrapnel inside and Morris said he didn't want to know anything about it.

5. Morris said approximately 4 weeks ago Eric Harris or "Reb" as he wanted to be called, told Morris that he wanted to put a trip bomb in the fence behind Blackjack Pizza. Morris said there is

a hole in the fence behind Blackjack Pizza where a lot of kids go through to gain access to the other side and Harris wanted to set a trip device so when kids came through the fence it would go off. Morris said he saw the trip device which was a CO-2 cartridge filled with gun powder. Morris said the cartridge had matches wrapped around the outside with a string attached as the tripping device. Morris said when the string was tripped it would cause the matches to light, which would light the fuse, and the cartridge would explode. Morris said he told Eric Harris not to put the trip bomb in the fence. Morris said he is unsure whether Harris ever did or not. Christopher Morris said he then began realizing that Klebold and Harris were setting off to many bombs and that they were making bombs that could actually hurt someone. Chris Morris said it was around this same time that he heard from employees at work that Eric Harris was trying to have someone purchase weapons for him at a gun show. Morris was unsure whether this occurred although he believes someone did buy the guns for Harris, possibly through Phil Duran a former employee of Blackjack Pizza, because Duran had mentioned to Chris that they had gone shooting bowling pins. Morris said that he heard from several different people that Harris got the guns although he (Morris) never saw any of the guns. Morris said that Phil Duran later told him that they were playing with an AK-47 although he never mentioned purchasing the gun for Klebold or Harris. Morris said that he has only fired one gun in his life which was at camp and the only gun he ever saw Harris with was a pellet gun. Morris said that Phil Duran would be hard to track down since he has a new job in the telecommunications field and was out of State.

6. Investigator Vette asked Morris what time he made it to his first class. Morris said that his first class starts at 8:20 A.M. and he was outside waiting to get in the class at 8:10 to 8:15 A.M. Morris said that class is finished at about 9:20 A.M. Morris said that there is a five minute passing period and he went to his next class Government/Economic which starts at 9:25 A.M. and goes until 10:15 A.M. Chris said at 10:15 A.M. he left class once it was finished and drove directly to Cub Foods where he was in the store about 5 minutes purchasing foods items then drove directly to Cory Freezen's house. Morris estimated that from the time he left school at 10:15 A.M. until

he reached Cory Freeze's house was about twenty minutes or about 10:35 A.M. Morris also stated that he had his Cub Foods receipt at Cory Freeze's home which may show the exact time he was at Cub Foods, (this receipt was not recovered).

7. Chris Morris said that Klebold and Harris both have computers although they were taken away by their parents about a year ago because Harris and Klebold were arrested for breaking into a vehicle and stealing computer parts. Morris said that both Harris and Klebold were on Jefferson County Diversion for the violations and believes they were released from Diversion about a month ago. Morris was asked if he knew for what purposes Harris and Klebold used the computer for? Morris said that both Harris and Klebold used the computer for playing games between themselves. Morris said that a game called "Quake" which is much like the game "Doom" was played almost everyday by Harris and Klebold. Morris said that all you do in the games is kill and blow up people and he (Morris) didn't take much interest in the games. Morris said he was unaware if Klebold and Harris used the computer anything else. Investigator Vette asked Morris if he was into computers? Morris said that he likes computers and enjoys programming games. Morris said that he also wishes to be a computer network administrator someday after he takes all the classes. Morris was asked if he owns a computer. Morris said that he does own a computer although has no Internet provider. Morris said that he kind of used a friend's Internet provider whose name is "Chuck" although doesn't use that anymore. Morris said that he once used America On Line, about 5-6 months ago although could no longer afford the service. Christopher Morris said that his screen name is "Grunt257". Morris said that he and Cory Freeze have played games between computers without having an Internet provider by simply calling each other's modems.

8. Chris Morris was asked if he had anything illegal in his home or anything in his home that would relate to this investigation? Morris said that the only thing he could think of was a butterfly knife which was given to him as a present, by "Chuck" and some fireworks from last fourth of

July Investigator Vette asked Morris if he had any explosive devices bomb making material or anything of that kind? Morris said the only think he had was the firecrackers, which he obtained from a fireworks stand.

9. Investigator Vette asked Chris Morris if it would be alright to search his bedroom for any evidentiary items? Morris said that Investigators could search his room. It should be noted that Defense Attorney John Richilano was present during all of the interview. Furthermore, Investigator Vette told Morris that he would like to take his (Morris) clothing, which could assist investigators in the elimination of suspects. Morris agreed and advised that investigators could take his clothing. Investigator Vette also asked to take Morris' computer which was in his bedroom. Morris agreed. Investigator Vette explained that he knew nothing of computers and computer people would be brought in to view the contents of the computer. Morris again agreed. Investigator Vette explained that he would try to get someone to look at his computer right away although he was unsure when investigators would be done with his computer Attorney Richilano said in the past it has taken about three weeks.

10. Investigator T. Acierno read Chris Morris and his father the consent to search form which was signed by both allowing officers to search Morris' bedroom for evidentiary items. Investigators then made arrangements to meet Chris Morris, his father and Defense Attorney Richilano at Chris Morris' residence of, 5466 West Portland Drive. Upon arrival, Investigators met with Morris' mother who had apparently been telephoned by Chris Morris, his father or attorney and she had the computer disconnected and waiting at the front door (inside). Investigator Vette advised Morris' mother that a consent search had been signed and Investigators were going to search his bedroom. Shortly thereafter, Marc Allen Morris (brother of Chris) arrived and provided Investigator Vette with Chris Morris' clothing. Marc Morris said that his brother was afraid to come home since the news media was present. Mark Morris said every bit of Chris Morris' clothing he was wearing this date was in the paper sack.

11. Investigators responded inside the residence and to the upstairs (southwest) bedroom. A search was conducted as well as photographs taken prior to the search. Nothing of evidentiary value was immediately observed. Paperwork, photograph negatives, fireworks, computer CPU and miscellaneous items taken into custody (see evidence property unit report, dated 04-20-99) and transported to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office Evidence/Property Bureau who will continue to maintain care, custody and control of the items. Investigators cleared the residence at approximately 11:16 P M.

Christopher R. Morris, date of birth June 9, 1981, home address 5466 West Portland Drive, Littleton, Colorado, home telephone number (303) 972-8864, was interviewed at his attorneys office, Richalano and Ridley PC, 1800 15th Street, Denver, Colorado. Morris was advised of the identities of the interviewing Agents and asked about his knowledge of the events that lead to the shootings at Columbine High School on April 20, 1999. Morris was also asked about his knowledge concerning the purchase of weapons by Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold.

Also present during the interview was Dr. Gary Morris, Morris' father and John Richalano, Morris' attorney. Morris provided the following information:

Morris stated that he had no knowledge of, nor did he participate in the events that lead up to the shootings at Columbine High School (CHS).

Morris stated that he was one of the founding members along with Joe Stair (phonetic) and Tad Boles of what the other CHS students coined as the "Trench Coat Mafia". As a freshman at CHS, Morris was picked on because of his size. Between his freshman and sophomore years he grew a lot and he and a few others began donning the black trench coat/slickers in order to intimidate the kids that picked on them. Morris admitted he had a bad temper but he got his temper under control by the time he was a junior at CHS. The Trench Coat Mafia picture in the 1998 CHS yearbook was a joke as far as Morris was concerned and it provided comic relief to the kids that wore the black trench coats.

Morris began to know Harris and Klebold in his junior year when the three were in the same video production class and by the beginning of Morris' senior year he was good friends with both Harris and Klebold. Morris stated that Harris and Klebold shared many of the same interests in computers, computer games, etc. About the time Morris began not wearing his trench coat, both Harris and Klebold began to wear theirs. Morris believed that they wore the coats for self protection. Morris stated that Harris was not a very big person and was more susceptible to getting picked on than either he or Klebold, who were both over

six feet tall. Morris recalled that Harris was depressed about his size and getting picked on. Morris was aware that Harris' nickname was "Reb" and Klebold's nickname was "Vodka".

Morris began working at BlackJack Pizza, located at Pierce Street and Ottawa Avenue in the Pierce Street Shopping Center, Littleton, Colorado, in October 1996. By Fall 1998 Harris, Klebold, Nathan Dykeman, and Philip Duran all worked at the above BlackJack Pizza. Morris recalled that sometime before Thanksgiving 1998 Klebold brought into BlackJack Pizza a pipe bomb to show his friends. Morris recalled he got very mad at Klebold and told him never to bring another bomb into the pizza shop or for that matter never show another pipe bomb to him because he knew how stupid it was to have a pipe bomb and how much trouble Klebold could get into if the police found out he had a pipe bomb.

After Christmas Morris began to think that Harris was becoming more depressed. For what reason Morris did not know. Morris stated that about two months ago he began drifting away from Harris as their interests were changing. Morris had a girlfriend, Nicole Markham, and Harris began getting into German music and books that didn't interest Morris. Morris recalled going to a German heavy metal concert with Harris that featured a band called Ramstein. Morris also recalled that Harris began reading books on Hitler and concentration camps. Morris stated that he was involved with his own life and not Harris' and the two grew apart.

Morris had bowling classes on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday with Harris, Klebold, and Dykeman and would associate with the above individuals during school hours but stopped doing social things with them. On occasion Harris would pick up Morris at Morris' home and drive him to bowling class and on some occasions Harris would drive Morris home from school.

Approximately one month ago Harris brought a CO2 cartridge filled with what Morris thought was gunpowder into the BlackJack Pizza. Harris told Morris that it was a "trip bomb" for the unknown people that were crawling through the fence behind BlackJack. Morris told the interviewing Agents that the BlackJack employees were constantly fixing the fence that unknown people were crawling through and it annoyed the BlackJack

employees. Morris thought a trip bomb was a little extreme for people crawling through the fence. Harris told Morris the trip bomb was just to scare the people. Morris described the trip bomb as a CO2 cartridge wrapped in duct tape and fused with matches and a string. Morris stated that possibly Klebold and Dykeman were at the BlackJack Pizza when Harris brought in the trip bomb.

Morris recalled on another occasion, Harris and Klebold had set off a device behind BlackJack Pizza but Morris was not sure what kind of a device it was.

Morris restated that over the last month or so he did not see Harris or Klebold much, except at school, because he was hanging around Corey Friesen a lot. Friesen knew Harris and Klebold. Morris did attend a birthday get together for Harris on Harris' 18th birthday. Morris stated that Harris, Klebold, Morris, Friesen, and Markham went to the Draft Bar, located at Southwest Plaza Shopping Center, to celebrate Harris' birthday.

Morris went to prom Saturday night, April 17, 1999 with Markham. Morris and Markham went with another couple, George (last name unknown) and a friend of Markham's, whose name Morris could not recall. Morris stated Klebold went to prom with Robin Anderson and Dykeman went to prom with Christi Epling. Harris did not go to prom as he could not find a date. Morris stated that he and others tried to help Harris find a date to prom but they were unsuccessful. Harris did attend After Prom and Harris actually went into the school for After Prom with Morris, Markham and the other couple. Harris, and Klebold played the poker tables together and everyone seemed to be having a good time. Morris said he last saw Harris and Klebold sometime around 1:30am - 2:00am. Morris and Markham left After Prom at approximately 5am. Morris and Markham went to Markham's residence and stayed there until Sunday afternoon.

On Sunday April 18, 1999, Morris spent the afternoon between Friesen's residence and Morris' residence installing stereo equipment in his car.

On Monday, April 19, 1999, Morris followed Harris to bowling class at Belleview Lanes and was there with Harris, Klebold, and Dykeman. After the class all four went to a nearby

King Soopers for donuts. Morris returned to school and attended his classes. Morris did not recall if Harris and/or Klebold returned to classes on Monday. Morris stated after his classes were over he returned to his residence where he took a nap. At approximately 2:00pm Markham arrived at Morris' residence and woke him up. At 2:30pm Morris followed Markham back by CHS where Markham had to stop for a choir robe fitting. Morris did not stop at school but continued on to Friesen's residence. Morris stated that at about 3:30pm Markham also came to Friesen's residence and the two left and went back to Markham's residence. At approximately 8pm Morris left Markham's residence and returned to Friesen's. Morris and Friesen then went to see their friend Charles Phillip II who was working at Video City, located at Kipling and Jewell, Lakewood, Colorado. They stayed at Video City until approximately 10pm talking to Phillips and playing video games. At 10pm Morris and Friesen returned to Friesen's residence and played the video game Friesen had rented at Video City. Morris went home at 12 - 12:30am.

On Tuesday, April 20, 1999, Morris waited for Harris to share a ride to bowling class. At 5:50am Harris did not show, so at approximately 6:00am Morris drove himself to the Belleview Lanes. When he arrived at the bowling alley he picked up his bowling ball and shoes and waited for the others to arrive. Soon thereafter Dykeman showed up and asked where Harris and Klebold were. Morris told Dykeman that he did not know where the other two were and Morris and Dykeman continued on with the class and bowled two games, beginning at 6:30am.

When bowling class was over, Morris went to McDonald's and then to Clement Park. Morris was having problems with his car overheating and thought he would leave his car at Clement Park instead of parking at the CHS parking lot. Morris began talking to the unknown male parked beside him and eventually decided to take the chance of his car overheating in the student parking lot and gave the kid a ride to CHS parking lot.

Morris attended his second hour class, which started at 8:20am. This class is with Kenneth Friesen, the father of Corey Friesen. Morris then went to his third hour Government/Economics class taught by Mr Tenoli (phonetic). This class began sometime after 9:00am and ended at approximately 10:15am. Morris stated that his fourth hour class is Acting and that he had missed a lot

of the classes prior to April 20, 1999 and had not attended for several days/weeks, as he knew he was going to fail the class anyway.

At approximately 10:15am, April 20, 1999, Morris left CHS and went to Cub Foods, in a close by shopping center, on his way to Corey Friesen's house. Morris stated that at the time of the shootings he was playing computer games at Friesen's house with Corey. Morris stated it was not until Mrs. Friesen called and told the boys about the shootings and questioned whether they had heard from Kenneth Friesen.

As the facts of the shooting began coming over the television Morris began to suspect that Harris, Klebold, and possible others were involved. Morris made numerous attempts to contact Jefferson County Sheriff's Office (JCSO), to tell them what he knew about Harris and Klebold. Morris stated that JCSO kept putting him off or the line was constantly busy so he decided to go to Clement Park so he could tell what he knew. When Morris arrived at Clement Park he was eventually detained by JCSO and later debriefed.

Just weeks prior to the CHS shootings Morris began to notice that Harris was becoming more aggressive and was picking fights with other people. This made Morris very angry because it appeared to Morris that Harris kept expecting Morris to bail him out of these fights. Morris also recalled approximately one week before the CHS shootings that Harris had asked Morris if he could store some fireworks at Morris' house. Morris declined, telling Harris that it would make his Mom too mad. Neither Morris or Harris brought the subject of fireworks up after that exchange.

Morris was unaware of any Websites that Harris had.

After the shootings, Morris stated that his girlfriend, Markham had recalled in retrospect that approximately one to two weeks prior to the shooting she had observed Harris and Klebold in the CHS cafeteria looking over a piece of paper. Markham went up to them and asked what they were doing. Markham told Morris that were trying to hold the paper back where she could not read what was on it so she teasingly grabbed the paper from them. On the paper was a diagram of the school cafeteria along with the location of the cameras.

Morris was then asked by the interviewing Agents about any knowledge he may have of where the weapons used in the shootings came from. Morris stated that he did recall another BlackJack Pizza employee, Phil Duran, had taken Harris and Klebold shooting, and believed they had gone to gun shows together. Morris had overheard Duran talking to Harris and Klebold about the gun shows. Approximately three weeks to one month ago Morris also overheard two other BlackJack Pizza employees, James and Billy (last names unknown), talking about Harris and Klebold having purchased a gun from Duran or one of Duran's friends. Morris recalled that the gun they purchased was an AK-47 or a "Tech". Morris stated at the time he did not know what a Tech was, and in fact at first thought they were talking about a computer. In any event Morris thought to himself that this talk about guns was not good. However he had no idea of the events that were going to happen at CHS on April 20, 1999.

Morris was aware that Duran lived in a house with several other people to include another BlackJack Pizza employee, Angel (last name unknown).

Morris was aware that Duran was a marijuana smoker, as were Harris and Klebold. Morris knew this because Duran had offered him some at one time when Duran was giving Morris a ride home from work. Morris stated he observed Harris and Klebold smoking "pot" on one occasion. Morris had no reason to believe that Duran was a threat to him or Dykeman.

Morris concluded the interview by stating that he was more than willing to assist in this investigation and was asked again if he had knowledge of, or participated in the planning or execution of the shootings and bomb planting at CHS. Morris restated that he did not and as further proof, if had been aware of the events of April 20, 1999 he would not have allowed his girlfriend, who he stated he loves, in the CHS cafeteria at the time of the shooting, or his girlfriend's little brother, who came running into the cafeteria telling everyone to get down because of the shooting. Nor would he have had his best friend's dad, Kenneth Friesen, in the school at the time of the shootings.

Christopher Richard Morris, date of birth June 9, 1981, 5466 West Portland Drive, Littleton, Colorado, Social Security Account Number 521-63-0154, was interviewed outside Columbine High School, Littleton, Colorado. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the purpose of the interview, Morris provided the following information:

Morris was at Corey Friesen's home, a friend from Columbine High School, watching television when he saw a report on the shooting at Columbine High School. As he listened to the report, he thought he knew who was involved and came back to the school to provide information.

Morris believed the two students who were involved to be Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold. Harris also goes by the nick name of "Reb" and Klebold goes by "Vodka". Others he thought might be involved were [REDACTED] (a recent graduate of Columbine) and [REDACTED]. He felt this because [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were associates of Harris and Klebold. [REDACTED]

Morris was the first to start wearing a black trench coat. As others started wearing the coats, Morris stopped. He did this because it was no longer a statement of his individuality. Morris stated that he and the others were insulted by other students because of the trench coats. Harris and Klebold continued to wear the black trench coats and Harris wore his all the time. Morris believes Harris did this because the coat made him feel tougher. The name "Trench Coat Mafia" came about after Morris discontinued wearing the coat.

Besides bowling early in the morning, Morris' classes (for the morning schedule) were: first period - no class; 2nd hour - Mr. Friesen; and 3rd hour - Mr. Tinnelly. On April 20, 1999, Morris went to bowling, but Harris and Klebold were not there. After bowling class, Morris went to school and attended his scheduled classes. After 3rd hour, he left campus to get something to eat and then went to Corey Friesen's house. Corey is the son of Mr. Friesen, the teacher. Once Morris determined

When asked if Morris thought Harris and Klebold would set booby traps and explosives in the school, he stated that from what he had heard so far, he believed they might. When asked where Harris and Klebold may have gotten the guns, Morris stated that the shotgun may have been from Klebold's father as he had a number of guns and was a hunter. Morris thought that other guns may have been obtained through an older boy (early 20s) at the Black Jack Pizza. He mentioned Phil Duran as someone who might have more information or who might have actually gotten guns for Harris and Klebold. Morris recalled that Harris and Klebold used to get pins from bowling and use them for target practice.

At this time, the interview was concluded.

ASSIGNMENT SYNOPSIS:

A report was received through the Northglenn Police Department indicating Brenda PARKER knows some of the TCM members associated with the Columbine High School shooting.

PARKER was contacted by phone on July 13, 1999 She stated she briefly dated Eric HARRIS earlier this year. PARKER agreed to an interview at her home on July 14, 1999

PARKER was interviewed in her home on July 14, 1999 She stated she recognized HARRIS and KLEYBOLD when their pictures were shown on the news in association with the Columbine Shooting. She stated she has never attended Columbine High School, and that she met HARRIS at one of the Denver area malls in mid January of 1998. She could not recall the specific mall PARKER stated she was shopping with a girlfriend Keri L/N UNK and HARRIS and KLEYBOLD started following them around. PARKER stated she and her girlfriend went into a female clothing store and HARRIS and KLEYBOLD followed them inside. She stated they all began to talk and she agreed to meet Harris AT 88TH and Wadsworth Blvd the following day.

PARKER stated she and HARRIS began to communicate on the phone daily and would go cruising in her Mustang. She stated KLEYBOLD was with HARRIS most of the time she was with him PARKER stated they would just drive around and talk about racing cars, and where they worked. She stated HARRIS told her they worked at Blackjack Pizza, and when she would go by there they would give her free pizza. She stated she also met a guy named Chris at Blackjack Pizza. She stated she did not know

Chris's last name, but he worked at the pizza store, and was friends with HARRIS and KLEYBOLD. She stated Chris was described as wearing glasses, with brown hair, had a medium build, and wore army type clothes a lot. PARKER stated they never mentioned weapons, drugs, or any type of destructive activity. She stated she was really into racing her car and that was all they ever talked about. PARKER stated she and HARRIS also went bowling once and to Bandemier Race track.

PARKER described HARRIS as polite, happy, nice, and very complementary to her. She stated KLEYBOLD was quiet, and kind of goofy looking, and he wore funny looking clothes. She described his clothes as loose/baggy type, but never saw him wear a trench coat. She stated she went to HARRIS'S home with him once but she did not go in. She stated HARRIS went inside and changed his clothes. She stated his car was a black Honda 2-door. She stated she never saw any weapons or drugs in his car. PARKER stated HARRIS had a brother named Kevin who went to school in Boulder and they went to see him once. She stated he usually worn jeans, tee shirts, a backward baseball cap, and a flannel shirt. She stated he was clean cut, and she never saw him wear a trench coat.

PARKER described he relationship with HARRIS as friends. She stated they were never really serious, he was just fun to be with. PARKER stated she and HARRIS had intimate relations on two separate occasions. She stated she did not remember any scars or birthmarks on him because it was dark when they were together. She stated he was a smoker, but never saw him do any drugs. She was uncertain if he had a pierced ear, but stated he never wore an earring or any other jewelry that she remembered. PARKER stated they were talking in the fall of 1998 and she found out he was only 17 years old. She stated she felt he was too young, and she was shocked. PARKER stated after she found out he was 17 they sort of grew apart, and did not hang out anymore.

PARKER stated she called him on the phone in January or February of 1999 to see how he was doing. She stated he seemed very different, and was not friendly like he was before. She stated he was quiet, but he made no mention of weapons, drugs, or any type of destructive plan.

PARKER stated HARRIS had helped her with her computer when they were together. She stated her account was Bpmustang@aol.com. She stated his address was something with Reb at AOL or Prodigy, but she could not remember. She stated

she never got hers to work and they did not communicate on the computer.

PARKER called the Reporting Agent on July 16, 1999, and stated she had a photo and a recorded message of HARRIS. The Reporting Agent responded to her home and picked up the items. A evidence tracking form was used to document the items taken. A copy is attached to this report. The tape and photo were reviewed with Lead Investigator, Kate BATTEN. The photo could not be identified as anyone related to the case. The tape was reviewed and no information concerning weapons, drugs, or the Columbine High School was found. The voice on the tape did not sound like other known HARRIS recordings. The tape and photo were returned to PARKER by the Reporting Agent

PARKER stated she had met Brooks BROWN last year through Eric HARRIS. She stated she called BROWN around the first of July, 1999 to see how he was doing. Parker stated they went out together on the weekend of July 18, and 19, 1999. She stated they did not discuss Columbine, HARRIS, or KLEYBOLD. She stated BROWN did not mention anyone else involved in the shooting, and stated she had no information to add. PARKER did mention that BROWN had moved out of his home and was living in an apartment in Denver. The Reporting Agent told PARKER that he had not spoke to BROWN, and really had no questions about him, however, someone from the Columbine Task Force investigating the shooting may have some additional questions for her. PARKER agreed to answer any additional questions investigators had for her.

Jefferson County Investigator, Don ESTEP contacted the Reporting Agent on September 7, 1999 Investigator ESTEP stated he had received information from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) regarding Brenda PARKER The information received from the FBI identified PARKER as making statements on the Internet, connecting herself to the Columbine shooting

Brenda PARKER was contacted on September 7, 1999 in her home, at the above address. PARKER stated she had been busy working on her Internet business she operates from her home She stated the name of her company is IBC-10 and the address is <http://www.wppwired.com/cgi-bin/miva?/> PARKER stated her email address is bjpmatrix@aol.com.

PARKER stated she keeps in touch with Judy BROWN (Brooks BROWNS mom) She stated the last time she talked to Brooks BROWN was approximately 2 weeks ago, when they met and went to the movie, Blair Witch Project She stated they discussed how they each were doing, and really did not talk about the Columbine shooting.

PARKER stated she spends a lot of time on the Internet, talking in chat rooms and comments on bulletin boards. She stated she met a girl named Catherine on the Internet approximately 2 months ago She stated Catherine lives in Boston, and they have talked on the

phone, but never actually met PARKER stated Catherine used to have a web site dedicated to Eric HARRIS and Dylan KLEYBOLD The web site created by Catherine was called "A Memorial, Tears for Eric and Dylan" PARKER stated the web site contained pictures of KLEYBOLD and HARRIS, a list of their friends, and some of their biography

PARKER stated she does not know Catherine's last name, but she knows Catherine has a boyfriend named Paul and a roommate named Alex. PARKER stated she and Catherine have been planning on meeting each other, but the first trip had to be cancelled. Parker stated Catherine is coming to Denver on October 10, 1999, and going to stay with her. She stated Catherine wants to see Columbine High School

The Reporting Agent asked Parker if she discusses the Columbine shooting with people on the Internet. She stated that people she meets on the Internet always want to ask her questions about HARRIS and KLEYBOLD She stated she tells people what kind of people they were, and how bad she feels about the incident, but that is really all she has talked about. PARKER stated HARRIS told her his theory about a "Purple Monkey", and she had mentioned that to some people on the net. She stated the purple monkey theory had something to do with the moon and a monkey, but it really was just a made-up story from HARRIS

The Reporting Agent asked PARKER if she had ever told anyone on the Internet that she was involved in the shooting or had any prior knowledge. PARKER stated she had never told anyone she knew about the shooting. Investigator ESTEP asked HER if she knew who "VODKAREB" was on the Internet, and she stated that was her Internet name She stated Catherine is known as "BOSTENBITCH" PARKER was asked if she ever wrote messages to Catherine about being involved in the planning of the shooting. She denied having any prior knowledge, and stated she did not know anything about it until it was reported on the news.

PARKER was shown a partial copy of a message posted on the trenchcoatcp bulletin board. The message was written by VODKAREB and stated

Ok well I see that I can't trust ANYONE in this club so I took my pics and saying I am outa here!

P.S. whoever copied the pics like I said not to, I will find out who you are and you better watch your back! OH GAWD why didn't I

just go along with the plan? I could be with them right now BUT NO I WAS CHICKEN SHIT and now I have to be stuck here all by myself with pathetic little STUPIDHEADS! Well not ni more! I guess I will do what I should've done on 4-20 Boom! No more pain!


PARKER read the Internet message and stated she remembered writing part of it, but stated that someone must have added the last part. She stated anyone in the club could have added the last part

PARKER was given the entire typed conversation between VODKAREB and BOSTONBITCH and asked to review it. She took approximately 20 minutes to read the conversation and then stated she wrote it to Catherine. She stated she was describing a dream she had to Catherine. The Reporting Agent and Investigator ESTEP read various portions of the conversation to PARKER, and told her it sounded more like a discussion between two people than a description of a dream she had. After a lengthy discussion on the written conversations content PARKER admitted she wrote it. She stated it was not true and stated she had no prior knowledge of the Columbine shooting incident. She stated she made-up all the comments she had written to Catherine. PARKER stated she had no intention of causing harm to herself or anyone else. She stated she has no life and spends way too much time on the Internet.

PARKER continued to deny writing the threatening portion of the Italic statement written above. She stated she would take a polygraph, and cooperate with any addition interviews that were needed.

The Reporting Agent and Investigator ESTEP met away from PARKER and discussed the information obtained during the interview. PARKER was counseled about the seriousness of claiming to participate in the shooting, when indeed, that did not occur. She stated it was stupid of her to write that type of stuff and stated it would not happen again. The Reporting Agent and Investigator ESTEP concluded the interview and left the residence.

Investigator reviewed the interview with Jefferson County District Attorney, Mark PAUTLER. No further action was assigned at this time.

PERRY was interviewed in the presence of his parents, JAMES PERRY, work telephone 303-534-4000, cellular telephone 303-904-9153, and LYDIE PERRY, work telephone 303-744-6126. PERRY provided the following information:

PERRY dropped out of COLUMBINE HIGH SCHOOL (CHS) a couple of months ago and recently started a night job at SAFEWAY, located at Ken Carl and Pierce, in Littleton.

PERRY had been interviewed by law enforcement officers during the evening of 04/20/1999, concerning his involvement in the TRENCH COAT MAFIA (TCM), and his alleged associates, ERIC HARRIS and DYLAN. PERRY could not recall what DYLAN's last name was.

PERRY's sister, LYDIE, was in the CHS cafeteria on 04/20/1999, when the shooting began. She escaped the incident unharmed.

PERRY met HARRIS and DYLAN briefly last year during the latter part of the school year. At the time, both were beginning to associate with members of the TCM. PERRY did not consider them to be actual members, but both were good friends of TCM leader, CHRIS MORRIS.

PERRY did not consider either HARRIS or DYLAN to be good friends of his.

HARRIS was described as an angry, bitter person. Like a lot of the other TCM members, he had been constantly picked on, taunted, and had food thrown at him by some of the other students at CHS. DYLAN, a follower of HARRIS, was a lot more easy going and friendly.

The last time PERRY had any contact with HARRIS or DYLAN was circa January 1999, when he said hi to them outside of the school.

PERRY's family had a computer, but he never communicated with either HARRIS or DYLAN over the Internet. PERRY's Internet provider was ATT Worldnet. He spent so much time on the computer that his parents started restricting his access to it.

PERRY was the first person in the TCM who started wearing a trench coat. Before then, their group was known as the "Freaks." One student, unaffiliated with their group, came up with the name TCM because of PERRY's trench coat.

PERRY could not afford an expensive oil-skinned Australian duster, so he wore a cheaper, all-cotton black trench coat. PERRY was the only member of the TCM who wore an actual trench coat. The rest of the members wore an Australian duster.

PERRY was into the "Gothic" or "Goth" movement in Denver and enjoyed wearing black clothes. The true "Goth" movement was considered non-violent, whose members felt more at home and comfortable during the night.

The TCM initially tried to be a "Goth" group, but its members were too aggressive and violent for the movement. Some TCM members still liked to dress in Gothic style.

PERRY stopped associating with the TCM during the first day of school, circa August, 1998, after MORRIS threatened him with physical violence. MORRIS was angry that LYDIE PERRY had insulted him over a girl and PERRY had made a point to pass the message directly onto MORRIS. Afterwards, MORRIS had threatened to beat-up and kill PERRY.

MORRIS was considered to be more aggressive and violent than the other TCM members. He constantly picked fights with other students. PERRY considered himself to be a "pacifist" and was afraid of guns. PERRY did not like violence of any kind and did not own or possess any guns. PERRY stopped associating with the TCM when they became increasingly violent. They would constantly get into violent confrontations with other students using baseball bats and knives as weapons.

At no time did any TCM members make any bombs or explosive devices while PERRY associated with the group.

PERRY was shown a CHS class photo taken in March 1999, and identified MORRIS as the individual wearing sunglasses and a black beret in the middle, back row of students. PERRY could not identify any of the other students in the photograph.

So as not to interrupt his sleep patterns he stayed awake from 04/19/1999, to 04/20/1999. ROBERT PERRY stated between 8 am and 11 am he was talking to his Grandmother, who resides at their home. After Chuck spoke with his mom, he explained that he called his father at about 12:15 p.m. After he ended his conversation with his father, he then went to his grandmother's residence at about 1:00 p.m. Chuck told me that his grandmother lives in the area of Columbine High School, telling me that her address is 6885 West Rowland Avenue and his grandmother's name is Charlotte Phillips. Chuck remained at his grandmother's house for about thirty minutes and at about 1:30 p.m., he went to Corey Friesen's home, where he remained and continued to watch news media reports reference the shootings at the high school. Chuck was asked who else was at Corey Friesen's residence. He told me that his friend, Chris Morris was there and there were several neighbors of Corey Friesen. I asked Chuck if he was present then when the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office responded to the Friesen residence and picked up Chris Morris. Chuck told me that he was present when that occurred.

I confirmed that Chuck graduated from Columbine High School in 1997 and I asked him to tell me what his relationship was with Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold. Chuck explained that his senior year, both Eric and Dylan were sophomores. He knew both of them from school and he later worked with the two of them at Black Jack Pizza. Chuck explained that he had a Theater Productions class with Dylan and that is when he first came to know both Dylan and Eric. I asked Chuck to describe Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold for me. He told me that they were just ordinary kids and he had no idea that they were capable of going into the high school and committing the shootings. Chuck was asked when he last saw Eric and Dylan. He told me that it was a month prior to the shooting, March 1999, and they had gone bowling at Belleview Lanes, located at South Federal and Belleview Avenue. Chuck was asked if he noticed any problems associated with Eric or Dylan and if they talked about any potential shooting at the high school. Chuck stated that he did not see anything out of the ordinary which would lead him to believe that the shooting was going to occur. I asked Chuck if Eric or Dylan ever talked about the Anarchist Cookbook and potential ways to make pipe bombs and Napalm. Chuck told me that is aware of the Anarchist Cookbook. He has seen it on the Internet before, but doesn't recall Eric or Dylan ever talking about the cookbook. I asked Chuck if he had ever experimented with the making of pipe bombs or Napalm. He told me that he has never experimented in making any of those devices. Chuck was asked if Eric or Dylan ever spoke about any type of weapons or if he had any knowledge or if he participated in any weapons training or shooting with Eric or Dylan. Chuck told me that he had never seen Eric or Dylan with any weapons and he had never participated in any shooting. Chuck explained that he is not an advocate of being a gun owner and explained the only weapon that he has ever shot was a BB gun.

Prior to concluding this interview, I asked Chuck if he had any additional information to pass on reference Eric Harris or Dylan. He told me that he has no further information.

INVESTIGATION

On 04-21-99, between the hours of 0004 and 0035, Deputy Steve Luciano and myself conducted an interview with Jessica Rusch at her residence located 5888 West Fair Drive, Littleton, Colorado, in reference to the Columbine High School incident. JCSO had obtained information from Jessica's boyfriend, Patrick McDuffee, dob/05-30-81, that she identified one of the gunmen at the Columbine High School as being an individual known as [REDACTED]

Jessica Rusch provided us with the following information concerning the incident at Columbine High School and what she observed the day of 04-20-99. Jessica stated she was in the Science room for 5th period, and that the Science room is located on the second level of Columbine High School. 5th period starts at 11:15 a.m., and ends at 12:05 p.m.. Jessica stated shortly after class had started, she heard a loud explosion in the school, and initially thought it was some type of a Senior prank. Shortly after the loud explosion, she heard a series of gunfire, accompanied by a lot of screaming and yelling from other students from thin the school. After determining that there was a problem at the school, the students locked the Science room door from the

inside. Jessica stated she was huddled with her friend, Jennifer Smail, and at one point they observed an individual at the door to the Science room, and this party was carrying a large weapon.

I asked Jessica to give me the details about the subject she observed near the Science room who was carrying the weapon. She stated the individual was about 6'00" tall, skinny, and she described his manner of dress being in all black, telling me that the party had a black baseball cap on that was on backwards. She said he had a black face mask, black jeans, and a black trench coat. Jessica said under the baseball cap, she could see the individual's hair, and described it as being brown in color, curly, and about collar length. She stated she did not know the age of the individual. I asked Jessica if she could identify that person and tell me the individual's name. She told me she could not, but she had a conversation with her boyfriend, Patrick McDuffee, after the incident. She described the individual that she saw at the Science room door, and they came to the conclusion that it was [REDACTED] because McDuffee knew he was associated with the gang known as the Trench Coat Mafia.

I asked Jessica if she could tell me how many times she has either seen or spoken with [REDACTED]. She said she has seen him around school probably three or four times, and that it would have been last year. I again asked Jessica how she came to the conclusion that the individual she saw at the Science room door was [REDACTED]. She stated her boyfriend, McDuffee, is associates with members of the Trench Coat Mafia. I asked her how close of an association her boyfriend has with this group. She stated she doesn't know, but he knew or knows quite a few of the members of the group. She then reiterated that after she described the gunman she observed in Columbine High School, that it was Patrick McDuffee that said it sounded like [REDACTED] from the description that she gave.

Jessica stated the individual she observed in all black, who was carrying the long gun, was unable to get into the Science room, and walked away from the door. Jessica stated after the party with the gun disappeared from the window, that a teacher known as Mr. Sanders entered into the classroom from an adjoining classroom, and that he had been shot in the back area. Jessica stated students then rendered aid to Mr. Sanders. Jessica told me that they remained locked in the Science room anywhere from three to four hours before they were removed by SWAT Teams.

After Jessica provided her initial statement, I then asked her to try and give me a description of the long gun that she saw the suspect carrying. She stated she could not tell me what the gun, as far as the brand or caliber was, she just knew it was a long gun. Jessica did say that her friend, Jennifer Small, told her it was a sawed off shotgun.

Jessica was asked if she knew of any other individuals who belong to the Trench Coat Mafia other than the suspects that were initially at the school. She stated the only other person she knows involved in this group is a Joe Stair, and she relayed the information that after she was taken from Columbine High School, that she remembers seeing Stair north of the school near Clement Park at the soccer fields, and that Stair was talking with a law enforcement officer. She described Stair as being in a Columbine Rebels gym shirt and blue jeans, and she described his long blondish hair. Jessica said she saw him as she was being taken to Leewood Elementary. I again asked Jessica if she knew what her boyfriend, McDuffee's, relationship was with the Trench Coat Mafia. Again, she told me he knows several members of the group, but she did not know the relationship, and as far as she knows he is not a member of the group.

At the conclusion of our interview with Jessica, I provided her with a business card and asked that she contact me if she has any additional information to provide.

Sergeant was shown a photograph from the Denver Post, dated April 22, 1999. Sergeant advised that the photograph was taken in mid-June, 1998, at the residence of Kirsten Thiebault.

Sergeant identified the following individuals in the photograph, commonly known at CHS as the Trench Coat Mafia. The term TCM was given to the group as a derogatory nickname. Chris Morris purchase a black trench coat two years ago and the rest of the group began wearing them to school. Sergeant bought his black trench coat from Morris but hasn't worn it recently. (Orginial photograph will be placed in a 1-A envelope and a copy is attached to the FD-302):

1. Josh Barnes

Sergeant has known Barnes for approximately 8 to 9 years and contacted Barnes 6 months ago. Barnes graduated from Hertiage High School in 1998.

Sergeant has known Markhim for approximately 3 years. Markhim is a junior at CHS and is dating Morris.

6. Horst Last Name Unknown (LNU)

Sergeant met Horst LNU 8 or 9 months ago and was in contact with Horst LNU 4 or 5 months ago.. Horst LNU is a friend of Barnes. Horst LNU is a senior or has graduated from Heritage High School.

7. Chuck LNU

Sergeant has known Chuck LNU for 1 1/2 years and contacted Chuck LNU on April 22, 1999, at the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office while giving statements. Chuck LNU graduated from CHS in 1996 and is a friend of Morris.

8. Kirsten Thiebault

Sergeant has known Thiebault for 2 years and Thiebault is a junior at CHS.

Sergeant advised that the following individuals associate with the TCM:

Dickey is a freshman at CHS, transferring from Colorado Finest, an alternative high school.

Thaddeus Boles

Boles is a good friend of Morris and works at Echo Star Communications. Boles dropped out of CHS in the fall, 1998 and is working on his Graduate Equalivancy Degree (GED). Boles has a home telephone number of (303) 973-9159.

During the 1997-1998 school year, Sergeant did not like athletes due to the athletes making fun of him and his associates.

During the summer, 1998, Sergeant only saw friends that were in the photograph on a limited basis due to scheduling conflicts.

In the fall, 1998, Sergeant did not talk to Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold, only to greet each other while passing in the hall. Sergeant made friends with some athletes at CHS and did not have the animosity against the athletes like Harris and Klebold. Dykeman was seen during the school day spending a lot of time with Harris and Klebold, wearing a black trench coat. Sergeant had a video productions class with Dykeman in the fall, 1998 and a bowling class with Dykeman in the spring, 1998.

On Monday, April 19, 1999, Sergeant observes Dykeman, Harris and Klebold leave the commons area of CHS at approximately 11:10 AM. CHS has an open campus so students can leave campus and have lunch. Sergeant left campus and had lunch with Dickey, Kirsta Winer, John Paul Zerger and Frank Zerger. Sergeant returned to campus at approximately 12:35 PM because he has no 5th hour class. Upon returning to CHS, Sergeant picked up Dickey and drove her to her residence. Sergeant then drove to his residence and spent the afternoon at home, due to an illness. Dickey called Sergeant that evening to discuss personal matters.

On Tuesday, April 20, 1999, at 6:30 AM, Sergeant picked up Dickey and drove to John Paul Zerger and Frank Zerger's residence, arriving at approximately 7:10 AM. Sergeant, Dickey and the Zerger's drove to CHS, arriving at approximately 7:30 AM. Sergeant did not recall seeing Harris's red Honda Civic or Klebold's black Volkswagon.

Sergeant was in the ACE Room, an alternative English class from 7:40 AM to 8:20 AM, and then went to a drawing class until 9:20 AM.

At approximately 9:25 AM, Sergeant walked to the math room and talked to Dickey and Zerger. At 9:30 AM to 10:15 AM, Sergeant was in Relationships and Family class. After class, Sergeant went near the choir room with Dickey. At 10:20 AM, Sergeant went to his Government/Economics class to study for a test until 11:10 AM.

Sergeant and Frank Zerger left the school building and drove to the north side of the school to pick-up Dickey. The group were going to Burger King for lunch. After lunch, Sergeant drove to the Cooper 7 theatre, across Clement Park from the school to smoke a cigarette. A short time later, Sergeant heard sirens and Dickey received a numeric message on her pager. Dickey called home and was advised by her mother of a shooting at CHS.

Sergeant, Dickey and Zerger drove in the direction of the school. Three friends of Dickey were walking down the sidewalk and advised Sergeant of the shooting at CHS. Dickey asked about Sara LNU, a friend. Sergeant, Dickey and Zerger drove to Sara LNU's residence and talked to Sara LNU's mother. Dickey then received a numeric message on her pager from Nick LNU.

Sergeant and the group went to Frank LNU's residence, where Sergeant met Kirsta LNU's ex-boyfriend. While at Frank LNU's residence, Dickey got into Frank LNU's car and Sergeant following Frank LNU and Dickey to Boles's work place. Sergeant went to his home late Tuesday afternoon.

At approximately 7:00 PM, Tuesday evening, Sergeant went to the Arapaho County Police Substation to give a statement. While at the substation, Sergeant recognized Chuck LNU, Corey Freisen, Markman, Morris and Sheri Markman.

Sergeant does not recall Harris or Kelbold speaking German except for German lyrics from the music group, Ramstien.

Sergeant does not recall Harris or Klebold having knowledge of explosives or bombs. Sergeant is familiar with the Anarchist Cookbook, a book containing recipes for explosives and scams.

Sergeant did not communicate with Harris or Klebold through the internet. He did receive an occasional message from Morris and knew Morris had a web page.

Sergeant advised that Robyn LNU, a close friend of Harris and Klebold, may have additional knowledge. Robyn LNU is a senior at CHS.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT

On 04/20/99 at approximately 1150 hrs, myself and Detective d. Wykoff responded to Columbine High School on shots fired. Upon arrival we were directed to begin a search of the surrounding area of the high school for any possible explosives. After a search of the area, I was then directed to respond to a library west of the scene, to debrief witnesses as they came out of the school.

I began interviews of kids that had come out of the school, and during the interviews, was directed to a young man who was identified as an ex-member of the trench coat mafia. I began to interview this party (strain). During the interview he related that he was no longer a member of this group but, did give me an idea of the groups mentality. He went on to relate that the active members, were known to him as Christopher, and Robert both seniors. I was then told that these parties have extensive knowledge in military tactics, as well as in trip wires, and pipe bombs. I immediately contacted the command post and related this information. I then contacted the Jefferson County Investigators who took this party to be interviewed else where.

I then began to coordinate with the other investigators, relaying any intelligence information to the command center, that was obtained from interviews.

On May 12, 1999, at approximately 1200 hrs., Denver Police Detectives Marcus L. Fountain, badge # 91036 and Joel Bell, badge # 91009, interviewed Joseph Stair DOB 061380. The interview took place at 7097 W. Frost Place, Littleton, Colorado. Stair's girlfriend, Laura Bryan, was present part of the time.

During the interview, Stair related the following information:

Stair stated that on April 20, 1999, he woke up at approximately 100 hrs. Stair ate, then played video games at home. At approximately 1200 hrs., his sister, Amanda Stair, called home and spoke to his mother and that this is when he first heard of the shootings at Columbine. Stair watched the news for an hour or so, then he and his mother responded to the library near Columbine High School to pick up Amanda. Stair was briefly interviewed by a police officer at the library. That officer took Stair to the command post, where Stair spent another 10-15 minutes being interviewed. Amanda went home with her mother while Stair was being interviewed. After the interview, Stair was driven home by a police officer. By the time Stair arrived at his home, it was approximately 1530. Stair reported to work at 1600 hrs. (Arby's at Littleton Blvd. and Broadway)

As far as the trench coat mafia is concerned, Stair stated that he is one of the founders. Stair stated that he, along with Chris Morris, John Beachem, Eric Deutrau, and Cory Friezen, started the group around 1994 or 1995. Stair stated that they all shared the same interest in movies, video games, and bowling. Stair stated that he met Eric Harris and Dylan Clebold through Chris Morris approximately two years ago. Stair added that he hung out with Harris and Clebold only occasionally and didn't know them very well outside of school. Though Stair stated that he liked video games, and has played Doom, he also stated that he had not played any video games with Harris and Clebold.

Stair stated that he played Doom at his grandfather's house. When Stair was asked to give detectives his grandfather's address and telephone number, Stair stated that he didn't know either. Stair stated that he only knew his grandfather's first name, which is "Fred".

Stair has a computer, which he stated was built by Eric Jackson in June of 1998 for Stair's birthday. Stair stated that he had never communicated with Harris or Clebold via computer, though they had mentioned to him that they had a web sight. Stair stated that he wasn't interested in Harris and Clebold's web sight. Stair stated that he talks on-line to Brian Sargent, John Beachem and Tad Bols occasionally. Stair signed a consent for his computer to be searched and provided his password, which is "NATASHA" and his screen name, which is "DERNOCK".

Stair stated that the last time he saw Harris and Clebold was around December of 1998 around Columbine High School. Stair stated that they were in Clebold's BMW. He talked with them and smoked a few cigarettes for a while, then left the area. Stair stated that he has not had any contact with either of the two since then.

Stair stated that he has no guns and doesn't like them. Stair stated that when he was a sophomore in high school, he developed an interest in bombs. Stair checked out a book from a library and read up on how to make bombs. This book taught Stair about napalm B, field to air explosives and molotov cocktails. Stair stated that he was no longer interested in bombs.

Stair stated that he pays his mother \$200.00 per month rent for living in the house and occupying the northeast basement bedroom. Stair signed a consent for Detectives Fountain and Bell to search his bedroom. While searching the bedroom, detectives noticed newspaper articles about a previous murder suicide involving a former Columbine student killing his stepfather and then killing himself. These articles were on the dresser mirror. Detectives also found a newspaper article about Hitler. Detectives found what appeared to be a gun rack inside of the wall behind the door to the bedroom. There were no guns in it. Joe Stair stated that it must have been built by the previous homeowners. Detectives also found a notepad that had what appeared to possibly be the beginning of plans for a truck heist, which included a short list of names. Stair stated that it was probably written by Nathan Guest, who lived with the Stairs from approximately February to May of 1996. Detectives also found a blue folder which contained miscellaneous papers and a photo of Stair and Eric Deutrau. Detectives noticed a dark colored trench coat hanging on the closet door. Detective Fountain asked Stair if the detectives could take the trench coat, the blue folder, the Hitler article and the notepad. Stair agreed. Detective Fountain made it clear to Stair that various tests may be performed on the coat. These items were placed into evidence at the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department.

Detective Bell came across a 1998 Columbine High School year-book. In the book, Detective Bell found several written messages from various students. One message in particular read, "Chicos Groove", and then directly under it, "Yo Joe...Stay different, better than the norm! Jocks suck dick. TCM!! Later <<-VODKA->>"

Stair also agreed to take a polygraph and gave detectives his work schedule for the coming week.

Forensic polygraph psycho-physiological diagnostic techniques were used to determine whether the subject was being truthful or deceptive.

PROCEDURE

The subject was examined on May 14, 1999 at approximately 1357 hours. Standard polygraph techniques were utilized for this evaluation. Prior to the administration of the examination, the subject read and signed the Arvada Police Department standard polygraph release. The subject was advised of his rights per Miranda at 1358 hours. Subsequent to the advisement, the subject waived his rights and agreed to speak with this examiner.

A pretest interview was conducted during which time the subject stated his purpose for taking this polygraph examination was because he was asked if he wanted to come and do this. The subject further stated that he wasn't involved in this and had nothing to hide regarding the murders at Columbine High School.

In discussing the issues surrounding the murders at Columbine High School, the subject stated that the Trench Coat Mafia was first started by a group of his friends and himself with the original members being Cory Friesen, Eric Dutro, John Beachem and himself. The subject stated that when this group was initially formed, he did not have a black trench coat but did get one as time went on. The subject described the Trench Coat Mafia as a "support group" for the members against other students at school. The subject further stated that this organization was developed during his sophomore year.

The subject stated that he was a senior at Columbine High School when he initially met Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold. The subject stated that he sort of became friends with Dylan Klebold but that Klebold was never a member of the Trench Coat Mafia. The subject stated that Dylan Klebold really never hung around with the primary members of the Trench Coat Mafia but mostly hung around with Chris Morris.

The subject stated that he first met Eric Harris during his senior year a short time after he initially met Dylan Klebold. The subject stated that he met Eric Harris, who was in the company of Dylan Klebold at that time. The subject stated that Eric Harris was also not a member of the Trench Coat Mafia and in fact hung out less with the members of the Trench Coat Mafia than what Dylan Klebold did. The subject further stated that he did not get to know either one of them very well but would see Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold at lunchtime. The subject stated that he never got to be good friends with either one of them and that he never socialized with them outside the school.

The subject stated that the last time he saw Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold was six or seven months ago. The subject stated that they were together and parked in Dylan Klebold's car near Columbine High School. The subject stated that he was walking to work during that time and observed them parked on the street along with Chris Morris in the car. The subject stated that he hopped in the car during which time they listened to the stereo and caught up on old times. The subject further stated

that he never communicated with either Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold by telephone or computer. The subject further added that he had no close ties with either Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold.

The subject stated that Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold never talked to him about doing anything like they did at Columbine High School. The subject stated that they would say something like, "I'm going to get back at that guy," or "I'm going to kill him," but that this was always said in a joking manner. The subject further stated that they would also say things such as they were going to burn the school to the ground or blow it up but according to the subject, half the students said something like this, with it also being said in a joking manner. The subject further stated that no one ever seriously said anything about shooting students like they did on April 20th.

The subject stated that he was "completely shocked" when they did this on April 20th. The subject further added that his sister was in the library when this thing began and that he is glad that she is okay.

The subject stated that on April 20, 1999, he was home in the morning and got up at around 1100 hours, at which time he played video games until his sister telephoned home. The subject stated that his sister then advised him and other family members of what was taking place at Columbine High School regarding this incident. The subject stated that his sister telephoned their home between 1130 hours and 1200 hours and informed them at that time of the armed attack taking place at Columbine High School. The subject stated that his mother and he watched the event on TV for the next hour with him adding that his mother was in no condition to drive because of this event upsetting her so much. The subject stated that he had no idea who could be doing this while he was watching the event on TV even though they mentioned the fact that members of the Trench Coat Mafia were possibly involved in this incident. The subject further stated that he was completely shocked when he learned that the primary suspects in this incident were Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold. The subject stated that neither Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold ever talked about guns or making bombs or explosive devices with him. The subject stated that he personally learned how to make a bomb from several books that he obtained at the library but that he personally never made one. The subject further admitted that he has never fired or even held a gun in his life. The subject also added that he never went with anyone who even practiced shooting guns.

The subject stated that the last time that he was on Columbine High School property was two months ago and that the last time he was in the school building was approximately nine months ago. The subject further added that he does not know who could have helped Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold plan out this incident that took place at Columbine High School.

There were no further statements made by this subject during the pretest portion of the interview. The subject was then examined with an Axciton computerized polygraph system which is periodically calibrated to insure its accuracy and reliability. The instrument was correctly calibrated and in proper working condition when this examination was conducted. Four polygraph charts were administered on the subjects.

RESULTS

Polygrams two, three and four contained following relevant questions:

4. Regarding Columbine High School, did you personally participate in planning that armed attack?

Answer: "No."

6. On April 20, 1999, did you know for sure that an armed attack would occur at Columbine High School?

Answer: "No."


8. Regarding Columbine High School, did you knowingly provide any of the weapons used in that armed attack?

Answer: "No."

The subject's psycho-physiological responses to the foregoing relevant questions were indicative of him answering the questions truthfully.

DIAGNOSTIC OPINION

After careful analysis of this subject's polygrams, it is the opinion of the examiner that the subject has told substantially the truth.
