05/18/99, 0930 hrs. Valerie Jugert was interviewed at her home by Detective S.C. Shott #72049 (DPD). Her mother, Charlene Jugert, was present and sat in on the interview.

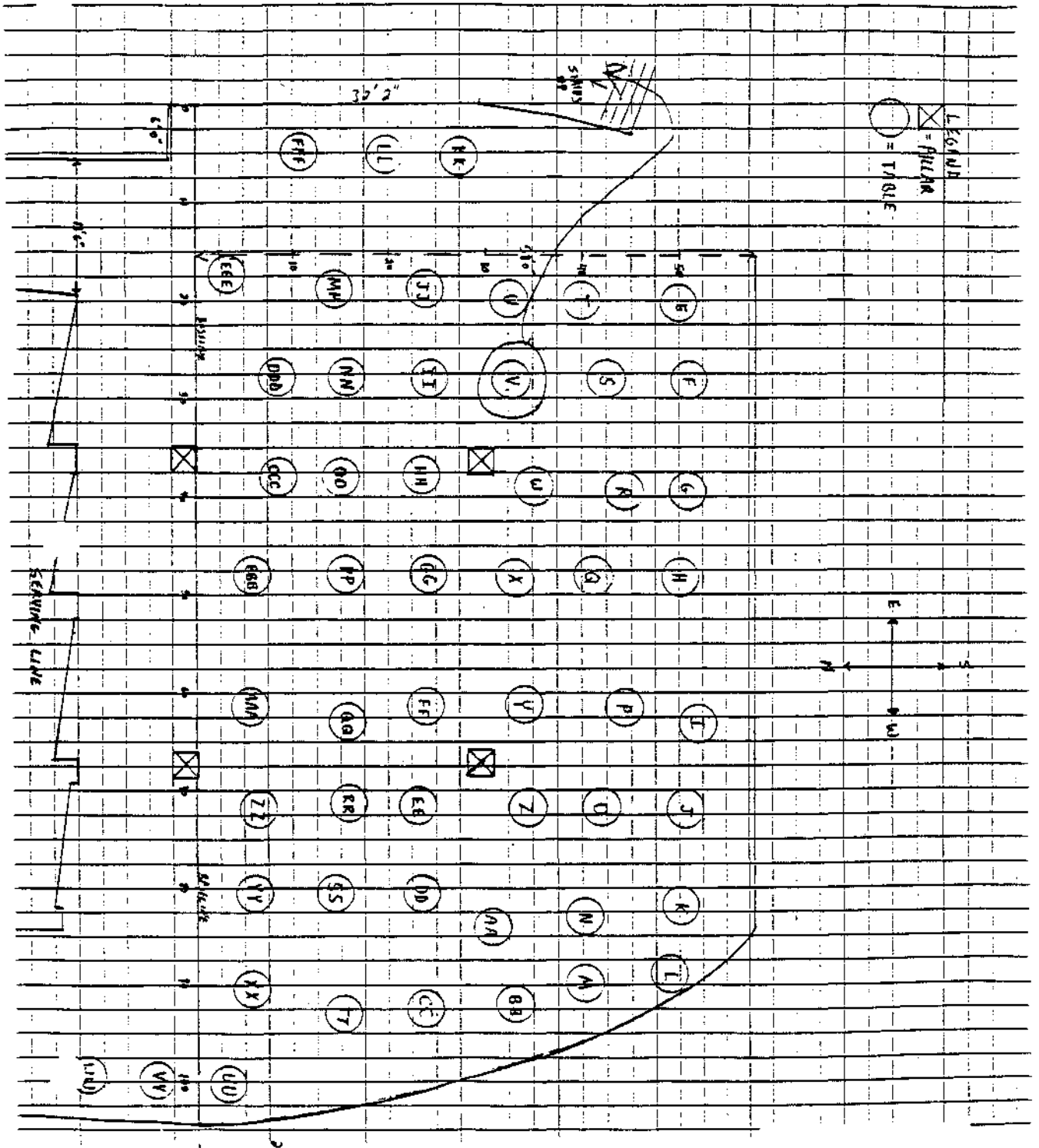
Valerie stated that attended her 4th period gym class, which she got early because she did not have to shower. She arrived at the cafeteria at around 11:00AM and she met with her regular friends, who she identified as Lorren Beyer, Sara Flipia(?), Julie Naslin(?), Alex Goldberg, Nicole Ray and Jennifer Munson. They all sat at their regular table she identified as table V on the seating chart.

Valerie said that she did not know that there was a problem until she saw Mr. Sanders run by and instructing everyone to get under the tables. She first thought that it was a senior prank and students started to get up to see what was going on. Someone yelled for everyone to get back down and she heard someone say that there were people with guns. Valerie said that when everyone started to run from the cafeteria, she followed suit. She ran out of the main entrance then up the stairs towards the library. She then ran down the hallway past the science and math classrooms then out a door on the opposite end of the cafeteria. She said that once outside, she jumped a fence, ran across S. Pierce St. and didn't stop until she got to Leawood Park. While in the park, she said that she could hear what sounded like gunshots coming from the school. She then ran to a nearby house to make a telephone call then she walked over and met her sister at the Leawood elementary school. Valerie said that while she was in the cafeteria, she did not hear any explosions or gunshots. The only shots she heard were when she was standing in the park. She did not see a gunman or anyone acting suspicious.

Valerie said that she does not know Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold personally. She said that she only knew them by sight seeing them at school. She was aware of the Trench Coat Mafia and knew that they dressed different wearing trench coats. She did not see Eric or Dylan on the Monday before the incident or on the day of the incident. She did not see a black duffel bag in the cafeteria prior to the incident nor did she see anyone bringing one in. Valerie said that she left her backpack in the cafeteria and it should be on the floor near where she was sitting. She described her pack as a black "North Face" and it should contain one text book and misc. school papers. She has not heard of any rumors or talk about any other suspects that could have been involved.

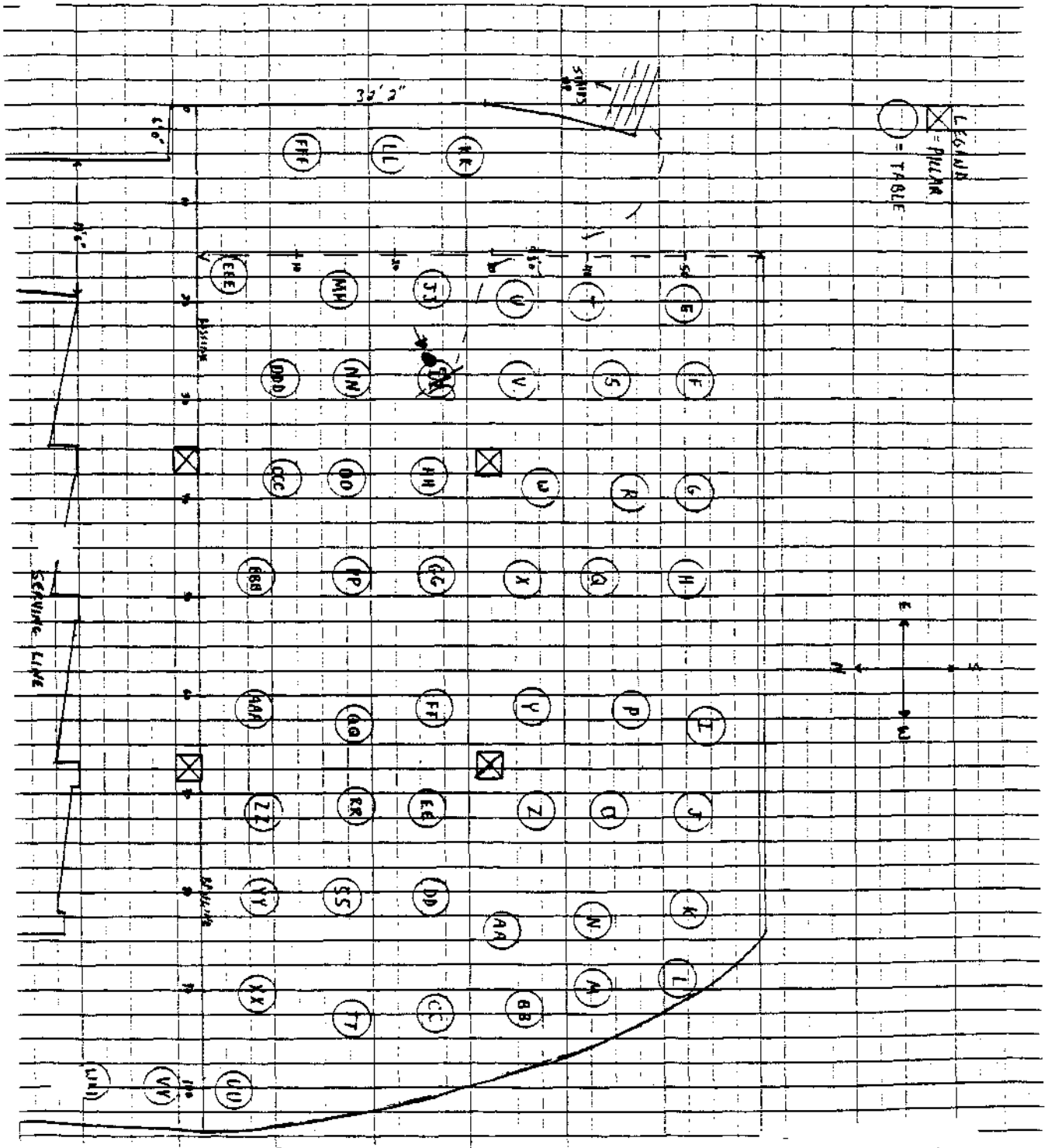

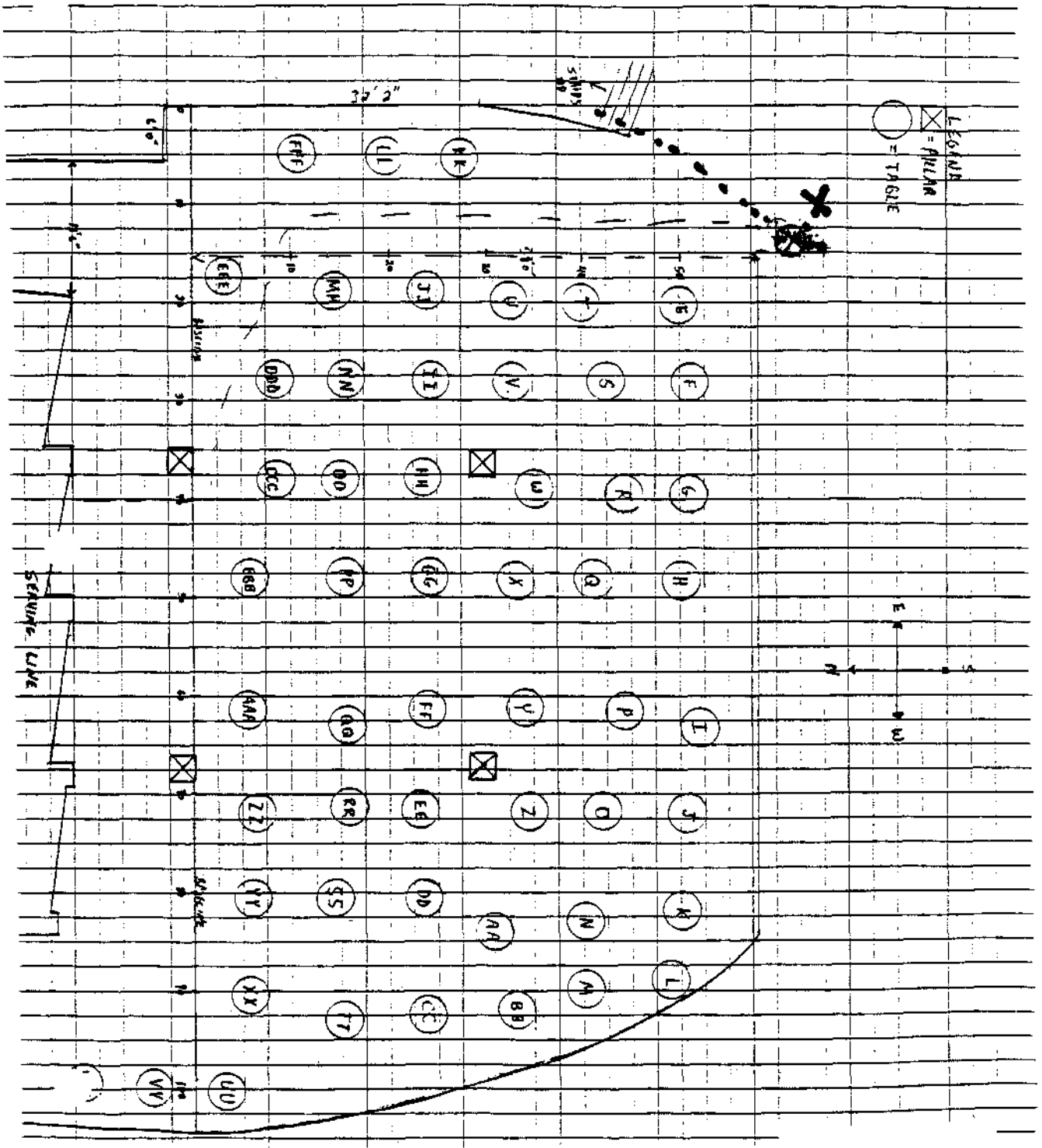

05/17/99, 1110 hrs. Lindsey Kastanek was interviewed at her home by Detective S.C. Short #72049 (DPD).

Lindsey stated that she attended her 4th period Spanish class that ended at 1110 hrs. She walked directly to the cafeteria and sat at a table that she pointed out on the seating chart as table KK. She said that she could not recall who was at the table with her but she could remember that when she ducked under the table, Shannon Myers was under there with her. Lindsey said that she was unaware that something was happening until she saw several students jump up at a table nearby. She first thought that there was going to be a fight. Then Mr. Sanders and a janitor came running by and were telling everyone to get under the tables. She said that while under the table, she did not hear any explosions but thought that she might have heard what sounded like gunshots. She said that when everyone began running from the cafeteria, she followed suit. She exited the cafeteria through the main door then she ran up the stairs, past the library then down a hallway passing the science rooms and math rooms. She exited the school through the doorway on the opposite end of the cafeteria, ran across S. Pierce St. and did not stop until she got to Leawood Park. Lindsey said that she was in the park for approximately 15 minutes when a teacher came by and told everyone run from the area.

Lindsey said that she left her backpack in the cafeteria on the floor near the chair she was sitting at. She described her pack as a royal blue "Jansport" that contained misc. school books and papers. She said that she does not know either Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold. She has never heard of the Trench Coat Mafia and does not know any of the members. She did not see any duffel bags in the cafeteria prior to the incident nor did she see anyone bringing any duffel bags in.

Lindsey said that the only rumor she heard was while talking about the incident while attending Chatfield HS. She heard students saying that they saw a guy wearing a white T-shirt throwing a bomb. She did not recall whom the student was who was talking about it.

Timothy Earl KASTLE, DOB: 07/04/81, was contacted at his residence, 8973 Brandt Place, Littleton, Colorado on April 24, 1999 at approximately 4:30 PM. He was advised of the personal and professional identities of the writer and Agent Jerry Means of the Colorado Bureau of Investigation. KASTLE's parents, Earl and Kim KASTLE, were present during the interview.

KASTLE advised that he is a senior at Columbine High School. He advised that on April 20, 1999 he was in the cafeteria talking to a friend, Adam SANDS, who was seated by the west window of the cafeteria. KASTLE said that he was not planning to have lunch in the cafeteria, but just stopped by to see friends.

KASTLE stated that he suddenly heard two loud bangs, and then heard a teacher, Mr. SANDERS, shout at everyone to get down. KASTLE stated that he first went into the kitchen, and then into the teacher's lounge. He overheard someone saying that someone had been shot.

KASTLE went into the bathroom, where he was joined by students Nick FOSS and Sean NOSSAMAN, and teachers Sue CARRUTHERS, Joyce JANKOWSKI and a female teacher whom he did not know.

KASTLE stated that when he went into the faculty lounge, he could see two bodies laying outside the window on the west side of the cafeteria. One of these subjects appeared to have had his face shot.

They locked the bathroom door, and heard numerous noises including loud bangs, screaming and the sound of people running. KASTLE stated that the sounds seemed to be coming from right outside the door.

Concerned that someone might come in to get them, they began to discuss climbing up in the ceiling to hide or escape. KASTLE climbed up into the ceiling, then assisted Joyce JANKOWSKI in getting up into the suspended ceiling area. JANKOWSKI moved to the west to an area just beyond the bathroom wall, over the area of the faculty lounge. JANKOWSKI then fell through the

ceiling, and into the lounge. She then scrambled back into the bathroom.

KASTLE stated that he crawled on top of a metal heating duct, and moved toward the kitchen, looking for a place to hide. As he did so, he knocked several ceiling tiles off in the area of a small bathroom which services the kitchen, and which is adjacent to the bathroom they had been hiding in.

KASTLE then began moving west, following the metal ductwork and then moving along a metal pipe held up by some wires. As KASTLE reached the area of the west wall, he looked back to the area over the bathroom in the kitchen area. As he did, he observed a subject in that area, whose head was just above the ceiling area. KASTLE said that the subject was pointing what he believed was a shotgun at him. He advised that he based this on the manner in which the subject pointed the gun at him. KASTLE stated that it was dark, and he could not see the subject well. He described the subject as having shoulder-length dark hair. KASTLE stated that he believed that the subject was Dylan KLEBOLD. He said he based this on the fact that the subject had not shot him, as KASTLE advised he is a friend of KLEBOLD's. KASTLE stated that the hair he described did not fit KLEBOLD, and nothing about what he observed of the subject led him to his conclusion that the subject could be KLEBOLD.

KASTLE kicked the ceiling tiles down where he was, and dropped through the ceiling. He landed in the faculty lounge next to the window through which he and others had earlier seen the bodies. KASTLE stated that at that time the window was intact. He then escaped the building via the door located just within the cafeteria area and ran to a marked police unit on the west side. He glanced toward the cafeteria area as he ran out, and did not see anyone inside. KASTLE stated that approximately one or two minutes later he saw Sean NOSSAMAN, Nick FOSS, and two of the teachers run out. FOSS later told him that he too had gone up into the ceiling area.

KASTLE recalled that at some point while they were in the bathroom area, Nick FOSS said that one of the shooter's was "the kid in the next class that wore glasses - Dylan". KASTLE also recalled a conversation with Nate DYKEMAN in which DYKEMAN commented that Eric HARRIS and Dylan KLEBOLD were not at school.

DYKEMAN told KASTLE that they had to be up to something, as they were never gone together in the past.

KASTLE described himself as being a friend of Dylan KLEBOLD's. He stated that he had talked to him the previous evening and were talking about some trades involving their fantasy baseball teams. He recalled that KLEBOLD talked about working a trade with Adam SANDS for player Roger Clemons. KASTLE characterized the conversation as being very normal, as was KLEBOLD's mood and demeanor.

KASTLE stated that he has known Dylan KLEBOLD for approximately three years, through school and their joint interest in fantasy baseball. KASTLE stated that he has had KLEBOLD in at least one class each semester since his second semester at Columbine High School.

KASTLE advised that there is a group of individuals who participate in the fantasy baseball league, and utilize a website belonging to Chad LAUGHLIN. KASTLE advised that the Internet address for the website is [HTTP://members.AOL.com/orgasmo007](http://members.AOL.com/orgasmo007). KASTLE stated that he only recently got an E-mail account, and has never received any E-mail on it. He advised that his screen name is "saltysquirts99", and his password is "wackit".

KASTLE stated that the "team owners" of the fantasy baseball teams included himself, Dylan KLEBOLD, Adam SANDS, Chad LAUGHLIN, Cliff ANDREWS, Ben HANSON, Dan PALMENTER, Jason SANDS, Jason FRASIER, Justin PALMENTER, Chris HOWELL, and Dan HALSEY.

KASTLE stated that he talked to KLEBOLD on a daily basis and currently had a class with him in fourth hour. They are both involved in video production. KASTLE stated that he has heard media accounts about videos that KLEBOLD allegedly made which depicted events similar to what occurred at CHS on 04/20/99. KASTLE stated that he never saw any such video.

KASTLE stated that he is not a member of the group which has come to be known as the "Trenchcoat Mafia", but has another friend who is named Nate DYKEMAN. KASTLE stated that DYKEMAN worked with Eric HARRIS and KLEBOLD at Blackjack Pizza, and that DYKEMAN was KLEBOLD's best friend until DYKEMAN became involved with Kristi EPPLING.

KASTLE stated that he had Eric HARRIS in his fifth hour class, and also spoke with him almost every morning. KASTLE advised that HARRIS kept to himself, and recalled HARRIS being upset about not having a prom date.

KASTLE was asked about KLEBOLD's hobbies and interests. He stated that KLEBOLD was into hard-punk music like Marilyn MANSON, and the German rock band KMFDM. KLEBOLD was also a Red SOX fan and a Roger Clemons fan. KASTLE stated that KLEBOLD was a good guy, and that what took place was definitely out of character for him.

KASTLE stated that he has never been to KLEBOLD's residence. He has never heard him discuss anything about guns, bombs, or mentioned things like the Anarchist Cookbook.

KASTLE recalled Nate DYKEMAN telling him that HARRIS and KLEBOLD never made it to their bowling class on the morning of the shooting. Chad LAUGHLIN also told him that as he was leaving campus and KLEBOLD was arriving, LAUGHLIN "flipped off" KLEBOLD in the parking lot.

KASTLE stated that he was interviewed on 20/20 at his residence. He said that while the crew was there, he overheard a female crew member saying that [REDACTED] had brought a duffel bag to the school. He did not know who the female crew member was.

On 05-06-99 at 10:00 A.M. Detective Terry Demmel, assigned with the Columbine Law Enforcement Task Force, contacted Columbine Senior student Timothy Kastle DOB 07-04-81 at his home for the purpose of an interview. Tim's mother Kim was present and stated that Tim had already been interviewed by the FBI but agreed to another interview. Timothy reported that on Tues. the 20th he had 4th period Newspaper class then went outside and talked with his friends Chad Laughlin and Jeffrey Marquardt. Tim reported that he couldn't find his friend Andy so he went inside the cafeteria. Tim was talking with his friend Adam Sands about baseball when Mr. Sanders came in and told everybody to get down.

Tim then ran into the kitchen briefly and then turned around and ran into the teachers lounge. Tim looked out of the windows and saw two students laying on the ground that were bleeding and appeared to him to have been shot. He could not tell if the students were male or female he stated. Tim stayed in the teachers lounge bathroom approximately 1 1/2 hours with friends Nick Foss, Shawn Nossaman and teachers Sue Cruthers, Joyce Jankowski and another unknown female teacher. While in the bathroom Nick Foss boosted Tim up into the ceiling. While Tim was crawling up in the ceiling he knocked a ceiling tile loose that fell into what he thinks was the kitchen bathroom. He then crawled across some vent pipe material when a party stuck their head up through the hole and pointed a gun at him. Tim stated that he is not sure who the party was but that he thinks it was Dylan Klebold. Tim stated that he had known Dylan for the last 3 years; that both Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold were in his 5th hour Psychology class with teacher Tom Johnson and that he talked with them daily and considered them good friends; and that Dylan had been to his birthday party last year.

Tim felt that it was Dylan who stuck his head through the ceiling and pointed the gun at him and then eased back down without shooting him. Det. Demmel asked Tim why he

thought it was probably Dylan that pointed the gun at him and did not shoot him with Tim relating that he had called Dylan Sunday evening the 18th at about 8:00 or 9:00 P.M. and that they had discussed a Fantasy League baseball game that they played with 10 other students. Tim explained that his friend Chad Laughlin played the role of the baseball commissioner or owner and that the people who played the game pretended that they traded players. He stated that in his conversation with Dylan on the 18th that Dylan had talked about trading someone for Yankee's pitcher Roger Klemens. Tim reported that Dylan's attitude and demeanor seemed normal.

In discussing any drug use that Tim was aware of concerning Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold Tim stated that he was aware that Dylan took some kind of energy pills that he bought at the store.

Tim stated that Nate Dykeman was his best friend and that he had called and talked to Nate in Land of Lakes, Florida last night which was May 5th. Tim stated that Nate had been very close with both Eric Harris and Dylan but had recently gotten a new girlfriend by the name of Christy Epling who, along with his job at the Firestone store located at Pierce and Elmhurst, had kept Nate occupied and busy. In asking what Nate had talked about in their phone conversation last night Tim stated that Nate thought that Eric and Dylan had probably carried their bombs into the school during a 2 hour block of time that they disappeared from the after prom party at the school. Tim himself was at the after prom party along with his mother Kim who acted as a chaperone. Tim said that he didn't realize that both Eric and Dylan had left from 2:00 to about 4:00 A.M. but that he did talk to Dylan about 4:00 A.M. about boxing with 5 pound gloves in a game that had been set up for the students. They decided not to box and then went separate ways. Tim stated that Nate had told him that both Eric and Dylan had disappeared from the party between 2:00 and 4:00 and that was his theory of when they may have carried materials into the school and hid them.

When Det. Demmel asked Timothy if Nate Dykeman had any prior knowledge that Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold were going to do something Tim replied that Nate had said he knew they were going to do something but that he did not know they were going to do what they did.

Narrative:

Interview with Matt Katzenmier

On 5-3-99, Inv. Reker did conduct an interview with Matt Katzenmier at his residence with his parents present.

In that interview Matt did relate that he was in the cafeteria at the vending machines near the west entrance and that he heard 2 shots and yelling in the parking lot and that Shawn Graves had been shot as well as another person.

Matt observed 1 suspect by the west entrance to the library and this suspect was described as 6-3 w/m long brown hair and a black ski mask and black pants and with an unknown weapon.

Matt then saw another male described as 5-9 w/m with black trench coat and a black baseball hat turned backwards and that this person threw a pipe bomb towards the doors.

Matt also states that he observed an older light green car, possibly a Buick, driving around the senior parking lot and that it contained one person whom he did not know, but that the car "peeled out" of the parking lot when the shooting started.

Matt states that he then went back into the school via the west cafeteria door and went to the auditorium where he heard shots and then ran to the entrance by the weight rooms and then out the building to the softball field, and that a Zack Pierce came out the door yelling to run that "they are shooting at us".

Matt states that he did not see the gunman come in the west door of the cafeteria.

Matt related that he heard shots or explosions in the school at the same time that the 2 suspects were outside the school.

A Nick Goodrich stated to Matt that a person was running down the language arts hallway trying to break windows out with a pistol handle and an unknown person stated to Matt that a person was in the main hallway at that time with a shotgun and that Matt did not feel it was the original 2 suspects.

Matt stated that Adam Beard is a friend of the Harris and Kliebold and that he feels that Beard knows more about the shooting. He also stated that a Micheal Bogacz, Adam Beard, and an oriental student known as "Kintero"(sp?) all left school just prior to the shooting and Matt felt this was strange.

At this time the interview was terminated

SECOND INTERVIEW WITH MATT KATZENMEIER

On 9-4-99, Inv. Reker did conduct a second interview with Katzenmier at his residence with his Grandmother present.

The purpose of the interview was to obtain a complete clothing description of the suspects that he observed.

He states that the 1st suspect was of the following description

black boots, black cargo pants, black t-shirt with writing, black trench coat, sunglasses, no hat, was short and skinny, with light brown hair, white male, with a single barrel sawed off shotgun and an undescribed handgun.

The 2nd suspect was described as follows:

black boots, black pants, black trench coat, black stocking cap and taller than the first guy, with ear length hair and an unknown weapon

Katzenmeier was shown a photo lineups and he did pick out photo #2 which is Eric Harris photo. He did initial above the photo.

He also states that at the time he observed these 2 persons that he could hear gunshots in the upstairs area of the school.

He was unable to provide any further info and the interview was terminated.

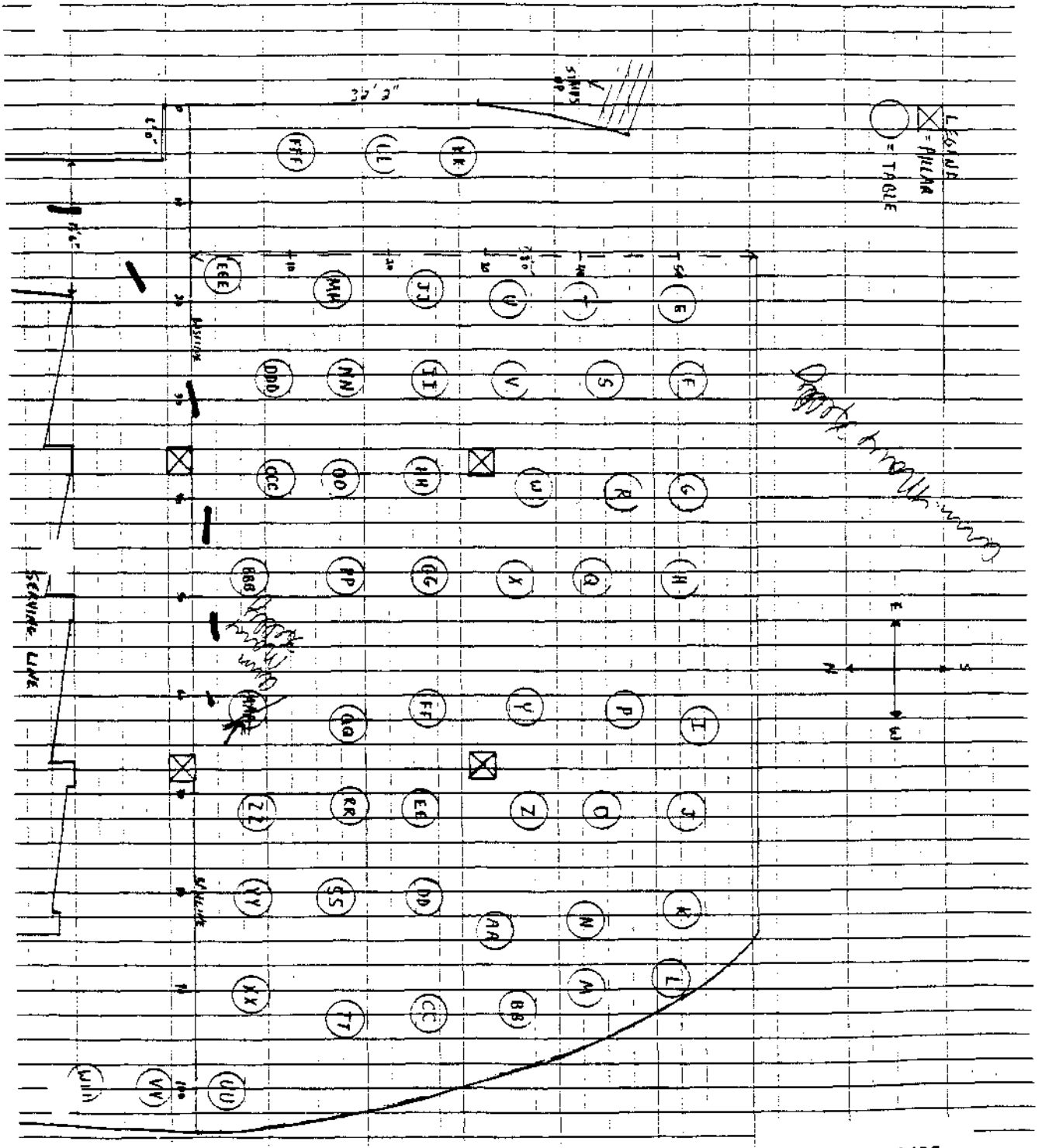

Ms. KELLY was interviewed on 05-25-99 at Chatfield High School, about 12:30 hrs.

KELLY had no information about any student who may have run from the room prior to the bell having rung to end 4th hour. She said that prior to the bell, the students lined up at the door as has been their custom in that class, and she said if one of them left before the bell, it was without her seeing.

While interviewing KELLY, I asked if [REDACTED] was in class on April 20, 1999 during 4th hour. Her initial reaction was that he was not in class that day, and said that he frequently did not attend class, but she was unsure due to the passage of time.

When I told KELLY that although two of the students who were in class that day told me that [REDACTED] was not in 4th hour class, the attendance records support that he was in class; whereupon she reversed and said she thought [REDACTED] was there.

KELLY said that the senior who sat next to [REDACTED] could probably tell us if he was in class that day. Her name is Crystal BRAGAZZI. (Lead generated).

I followed up by re-contacting the source, Greg BARNES (cell phone number 720-951-2180 / new residence phone 303-984-0343). BARNES told me that the student who left the room early that day was Matt RIECKS. BARNES does not recall BROWN being in class during that period.

Prior investigation (Control number 3354) reveals that RIECKS is a peripheral associate of the TCM, and that he left class that day to go to the tech lab to get onto the internet prior to going to

Information was received that Columbine High School counselor, Brad Butts and teacher, Judith Kelly were reportedly concerned about a creative writing paper Dylan Klebold wrote which detailed a planned shooting involving the Trenchcoat Mafia.

Kelly was advised that the above information was received and she voluntarily provided the following information:

Kelly stated that she is an English teacher at Columbine High School and Dylan Klebold was her student for a creative writing class. She advised that Klebold wrote a story for class as part of an assignment given to the students. Kelly reported that it was well written but very disturbing. She stated that she made a copy for the school counselor, Brad Butts and believes she returned it to Klebold after she graded it. She is not sure if she kept a copy which would be at the school. Kelly thought Klebold may have typed it on the school computer located in the Tech Lab. The teacher for the Tech Lab is Rich Long and the Lab Assistant is Peggy Dodd.

Kelly stated that the paper did not mention the Trenchcoat Mafia but remembers that it was about a man arriving in a town with guns who kills the popular type kids. The end of the story portrays this man or implies that this man is a God like figure. Kelly stated it was very well written, "literary and ghastly". She believes it was written in late February or early March of 1999. Kelly discussed the paper with Klebold stating its cruel and disturbing. She advised that Klebold replied that its just a story. She advised him she found it offensive. Kelly also stated she spoke to Klebold's parents at length about him handing in a disturbing story. Kelly stated that they did not seem worried and made a comment about trying to understand kids today. Kelly advised that her classroom is LA-8 (Language and Arts).

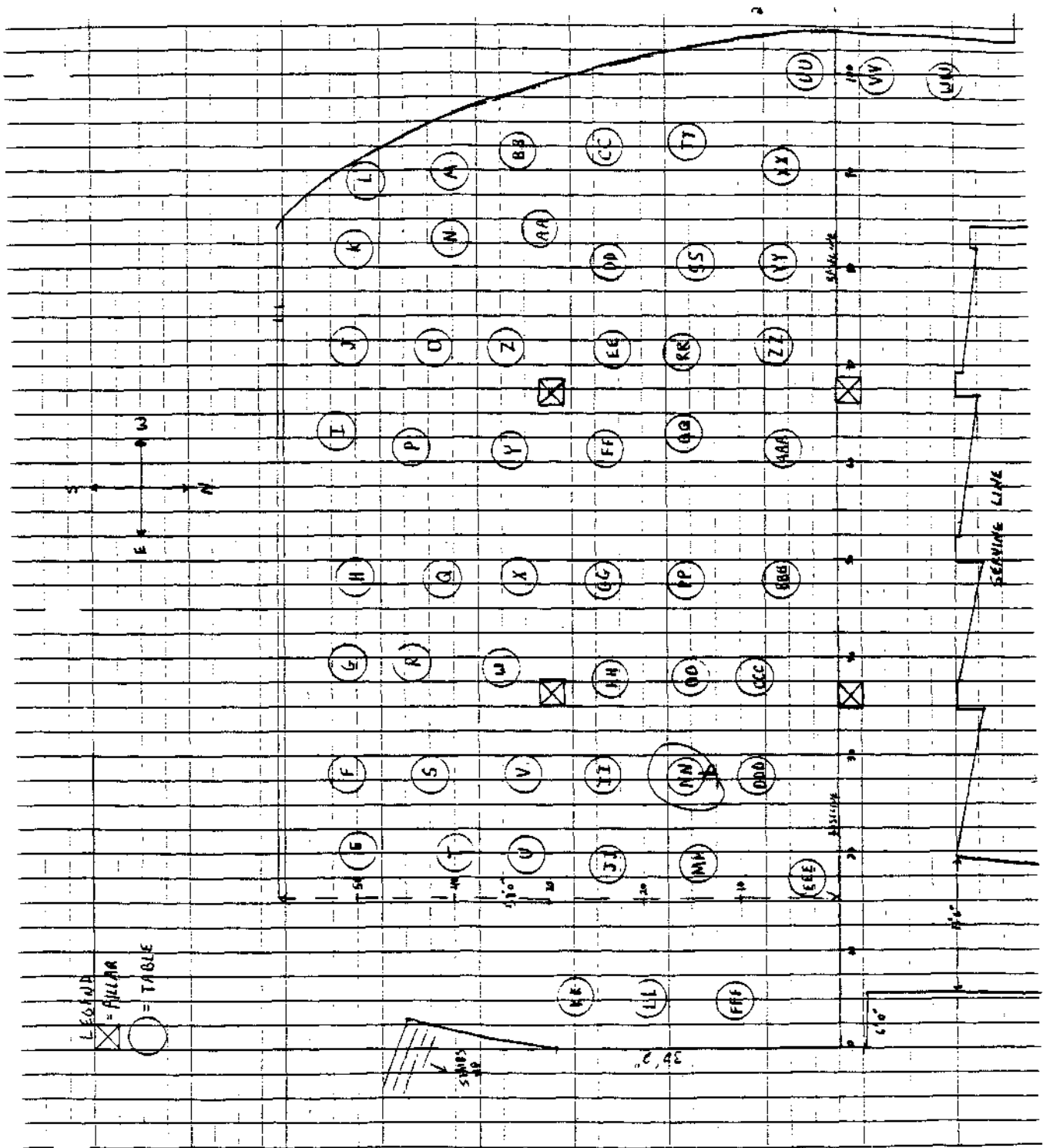

I then showed Lora a diagram of the cafeteria and asked her to circle where she was sitting the day of the shooting. Lora circled table "NN" and placed an "X" where she was seated. I asked Lora if she could tell me what happened that day. Lora said she was coming from the Language Arts hallway and entered the cafeteria to do her homework. Lora said while she was sitting there, the cafeteria became very quiet and she heard someone tell everyone to get under the tables. Lora said she then heard Mr. Sanders yell at everyone to get under the tables and stay there. Lora said they stayed under the tables for a short time and then Mr. Sanders told everyone to run upstairs. Lora said she did run upstairs past the science and math rooms and left the building through a door at the end of the hallway. She then ran to Leewood Park. I asked Lora if she heard any shots or explosions. She said that while in the cafeteria she believes she heard three shots and when leaving the building, she heard six more shots. I asked if she heard any explosions and she said not that she recalls, that she was just running and trying to get out of the school. I asked Lora if she had seen any of the shooters and she said, "no". I asked Lora if she remembers seeing two large duffel bags in the cafeteria and she said "no". I asked her if she remembers seeing anyone carrying or in possession of two large duffel bags and she again said, "no". I asked Lora if she remembers seeing Eric or Dylan on Monday or Tuesday and she said "no," she didn't know who they were. I asked Lora if she had left anything behind in the cafeteria. She said she left her blue Jan Sport backpack. I asked Lora if she had seen or talked to any of the Trench Coat Mafia members on Monday or Tuesday and she said no, she did not. I asked if she had heard anything about any other suspects making bombs or buying guns and she said "no". I asked what she was wearing that day and she said jeans, a blue tank top with a blue shirt tied around her waist. I asked Lora if she had any further information. She said she remembers hearing from someone (she does not know who), that there was another shooter in the school, who was wearing a white shirt, but she doesn't know who said that, and that's all that she's heard. I asked Lora if there was anything else that she can remember and she said no. I gave Lora a business card and asked her to call me with any further information and she said she would. At this time the interview with Lora was concluded.

INVESTIGATION:

On 05/05/99, I met with Jamie Kettlewell at her residence, reference the Columbine shooting. I explained that I was there to talk to her about the shooting and to find out where she was during the shooting. At this time I brought out a sketch of the cafeteria and asked her to show me where she was seated. Jamie pointed to an area by the service line and said she was standing there waiting to pay for her meal. I asked Jamie if she had a backpack on at that time and she said no, she'd left everything over next to the wall by table "K". I asked Jamie what time she was in the cafeteria and she said approximately 11:20. I asked her to tell me what had happened that day. She said while she was standing in the service line, a male known as Chris (LNU), ran into the cafeteria and told everyone to "get down" there was a "kid with a gun". Jamie said that she got down under a table and stayed for approximately 5 minutes. Jamie said she then got up from the floor and observed students running up the stairs. Jamie said she ran towards the bathroom area and heard approximately 5 or 10 students yelling to get out to the auditorium. Jamie said she went into the auditorium with numerous other students and while in there she remembered hearing, what she believed to be, the shooters pounding on the doors trying to get into the auditorium. Jamie said the shooters never entered the auditorium, that they finally gave up trying to get in. Jamie says she remembers a janitor coming into the auditorium telling everyone to run for the commons area, into the business hallway, and leave the school. Jamie said that she did run through the commons area and exited the school. I asked Jamie if she remembers hearing any shooting and she said she believes she heard shooting from the student senior lot. Jamie said that she heard from someone (she doesn't remember who), that Eric was standing at the top of the stairway by the cafeteria, shooting into the cafeteria. Jamie says she remembers running through the commons area to leave the school and it was full of smoke like something was on fire. I asked if she heard any explosions and she said that she did remember hearing an explosion while she was running to the auditorium. I asked Jamie what happened when she was outside. She said she went toward the Clement Park area and met up with Tiffany Burke, who picked her and other students up in her car and left the area. Jamie said that she believed this to be "strange" that Tiffany Burke was at school at that time, because she was not there during school in the morning hours. I asked if she knew Tiffany Burke and she said she had met Tiffany before, but Tiffany was being a "spokesman" for the girl who bought guns for Eric and Dylan, and that's the only reason she really knows of her at this time. I asked Jamie if she remembers seeing Eric or Dylan that day and she said, no, she did not. I asked if she had seen who the shooters were that day and she said, no, she had not. I asked her if she remembered seeing two large duffel bags in the cafeteria and she said no. I asked if she saw anyone carrying or in possession of two large duffel bags and she again said, no.

On 5/6/99 I interviewed 15 year old CHS student Carder Kingsbury at his home in Littleton, Co. Carder's mother was present for this interview.

Carder stated he was in the CHS cafeteria for "A" lunch around 11:20am on 4/20/99. He had walked to the cafeteria from Mr Allison's wood class, near the administration area of the school. He walked alone and arrived at the cafeteria around 11:20am. He meet up with Travis Jones and Adam Henchy near rebel corner. They sat at a table next to the student entrance south of the cafeteria. I showed Carder a drawing of the cafeteria which depicted all the tables. He said there are 2-3 tables directly across from the rebel corner store near the student entrance, which were not noted on the drawing. He placed an X and circled it, as to where he was seated with his friends. He recalled another table in this area, with a few CHS students sitting at it. Carder did not know their names.

He recalled that around 11:30am everybody in the cafeteria laid down, then stood up and began to run towards the steps that go upstairs. Carder stated he did not hear any gunshots, but knew that something was wrong. He recalled getting on the floor for a couple seconds, then he immediately ran out the student entrance doors and turned directly towards the junior parking lot. He and Adam Henchy continued running and turned right on Pierce street. He looked back one time as he turned on Pierce street, but only saw students running behind him. He also recalled seeing a police car driving down Pierce

towards the school. Carder stated he did not see any gunman, or any suspicious people wearing trenchcoats inside or outside the building.

He believed the group he was with, was some of the first people out of the building.

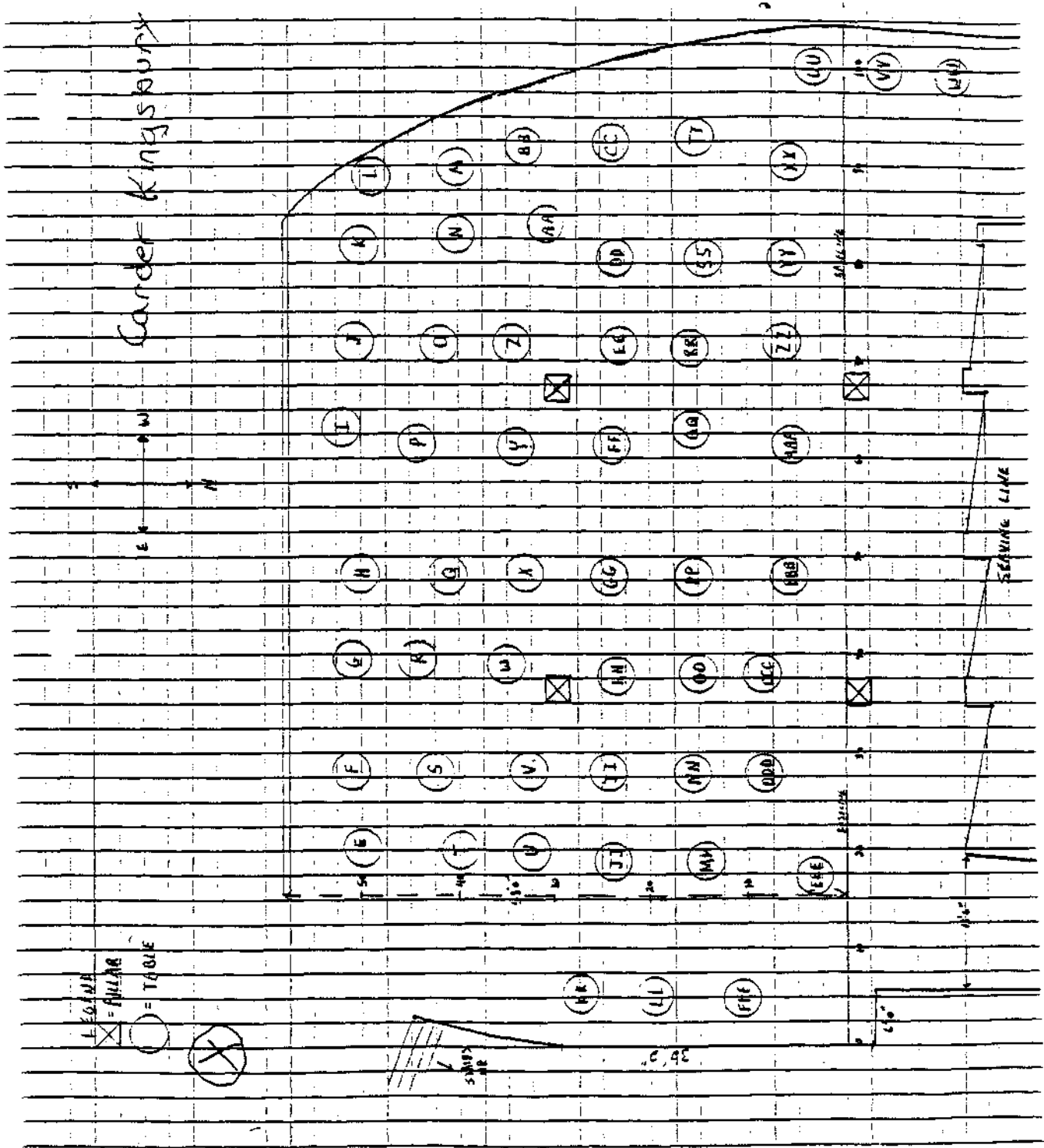
Carder stated he did not see any large duffle bags anywhere in the school as he walked towards the cafeteria. He did not see any large duffle bags in the cafeteria on 4/20/99, or the previous day. He had no more information on the shootings or on the TCM.

Carder left behind a black jansport backpack with books and notebooks in it. He could not recall what he was wearing that day.

ACTION TAKEN:

On May 6, 1999 the Reporting Agent Linda R. HOLLOWAY interviewed student Michael Edward KISH at his residence in Littleton. He was asked to relate what he did on April 20, 1999. He stated that he was picked up at his home by Mark RADTKE at 7:05 a.m. and arrived at the school between 7:15 and 7:20 a.m.

He went to the library where he played the game "blackjack" with Mark RADTKE, David SMITH, Kevin HANEY, Greg BARNES and Joel GOULD. He then went to his first through fourth period classes as usual.

He went to the lunchroom at 11:13 a.m. and sat at table WW next to the northwest door. During lunch he sat with Jeremy MULLEN, Mark RADTKE, Tanya WORLOCK, Sean NASHMAN (sp) and possible Matt WILSON (he was not sure if WILSON was there or not). He was talking and reading a magazine when he heard gunshots outside the cafeteria. He looked outside the window and saw a student shot (perhaps Shawn GRAVES). He stepped about 6 inches outside of the door, intending to help the shot student when he heard a loud explosion. He got up against the inside cafeteria wall next to the door. He heard other gunshots and ran into the kitchen area and then into the bathroom adjacent to the kitchen. He observed several other students starting to run up the stairs as he ran into the kitchen.

Once inside the small bathroom, he and the other students turned off the light and put their feet against the locked door. Other students in restroom at that time were: Jeremy MULLEN, Bret KASTAALNIK (sp.), Dustin (unknown last name), Fletcher (unknown last name) and another male and female who he couldn't identify.

They sat in the bathroom for about 2 hours. After they have been in there for about ½ hour, a fire started in the kitchen and the sprinklers started going off. He could tell that there were kids in the adjacent room. When they felt all was clear, they ran out of the bathroom and back through the kitchen and out the

cafeteria door (northwest door) and to where the police were waiting. He was interviewed by CBI Agent Larry Brown once he was outside of the school.

He does not remember seeing anything suspicious like large duffel bags or anyone carrying anything like the large duffel bag inside the cafeteria while he was there. He also stated that he knows by sight the two shooters (KLEBOLD and HARRIS) however, he does not remember seeing them anywhere in the school that day.


When asked what he left behind that day, he stated that he left a purple Xerox brand expandable file under table WW, on the floor. He was wearing a gray corduroy shorts, a white tee shirt with Stanley Cup Champs written on the front and a Bronco orange baseball cap. He did not have a backpack that day.

He had heard from student Joel BOULD that when he was running from the school, he saw three kids hop in a jeep by the front entrance, near the teacher's parking lot.

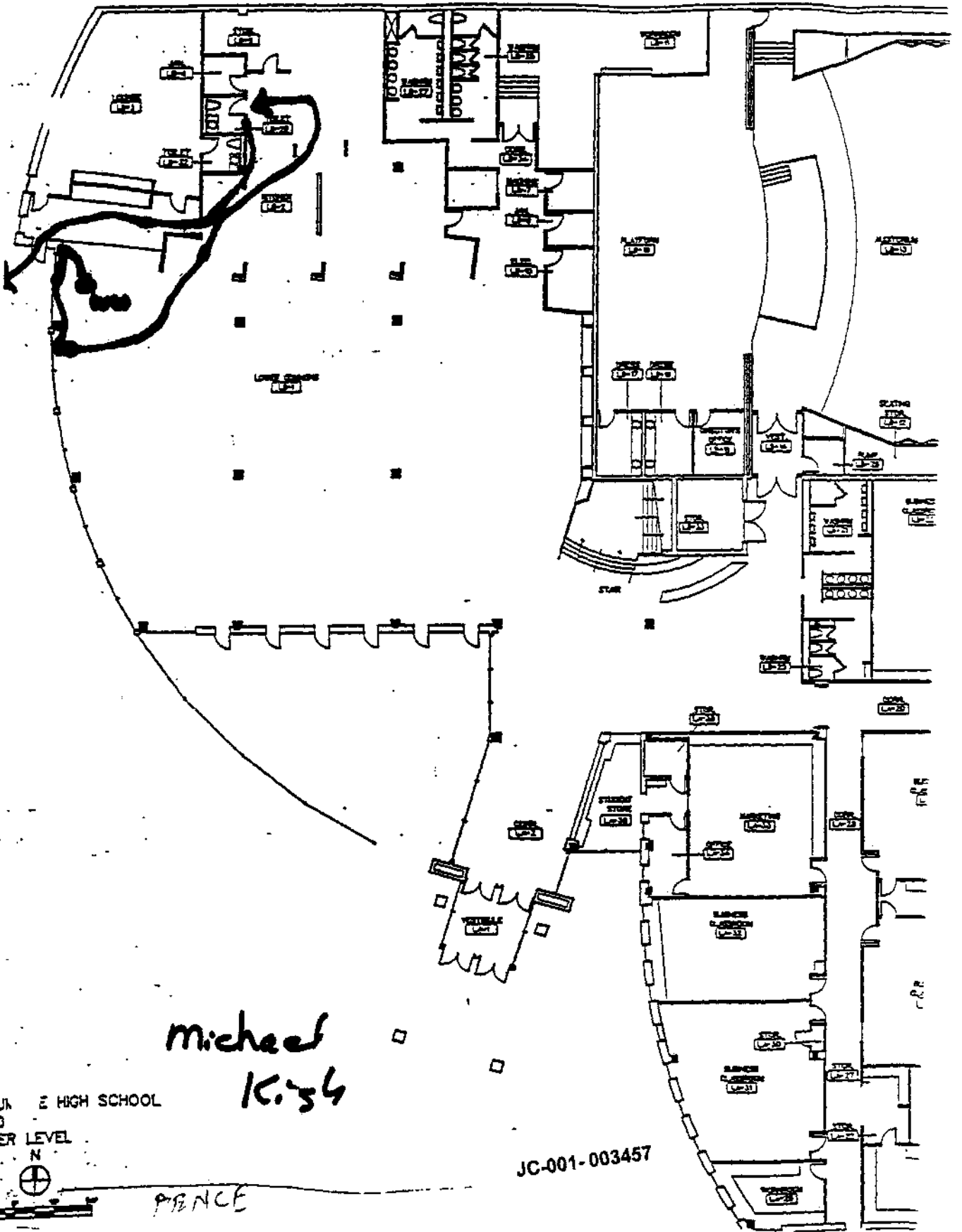
When asked about his knowledge of the Internet, he stated that he uses the Internet at school and at friend's homes. His screen name is "BLADE" or "CASH". He has not ICQ number. He does not know anyone with a double pierced eyebrow.

When asked if he remembered seeing or hearing the Thought of the Day, he recalled that he may have been "TODAY IS NOT A GOOD DAY TO BE HERE - 4-20."

The only other comment he had was that he felt that the "jocks" pick on other people at the school. He did not remember anything else of significance.

On 4/27/99, Jamie Klement, DOB 9/25/83, 7590 West Caley Drive, Littleton, Colorado 80123, was advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent, and the nature and purpose of the interview. She was interviewed in the presence of her Mother and Father, James Klement, DOB 6/3/43, and Sandra Klement, DOB 12/19/47. She provided the following information.

On 4/20/99, Jamie Klement went to school at normal time, approximately 7:00 a.m. She went to all of her classes to include her science class which ended approximately 11:10 a.m. She then walked with her friend, Lindsey Greer to Lindsey's math class. Jamie then met her other friend Kim Andersen, and they both walked to the cafeteria for lunch. They were sitting at table ZZ. Other students sitting at the table included:

1. Lori Reynolds
2. Elizabeth Noland
3. Lauren Maestis
4. Kristen Cardwell
5. Kim Andersen

Jamie went to the lunch line to purchase some food, and was on the line with Kristen Cardwell talking and waiting. They noticed that a boy possibly named Mark Opfer ran into the west door of the cafeteria, but didn't say anything. He ran past the janitor, and then was lost in the crowd. Students were standing up and looking out the windows on the west side. Jamie then saw someone fall next to the window outside. A second person then fell, and a pop which may have been a gun shot was heard. An object flew past the window, and two more shots or pops were heard. Bo Berry, and Tyrone LNU ran out the doors towards the parking lot, where smoke was observed. Chris Marcum and a janitor then ran in the cafeteria and began warning everyone to get down, because there was someone with a gun. At about the same time, Mr. Sanders also ran in and warned everyone to get down. More shots were heard, and Kristen and Jamie crawled next to the area of the elevators near the kitchen. Jamie heard metal pinging over top of their heads. Mr. Andres Jr. then came in and told the students to get inside the auditorium. Andres wanted the students to stay in the auditorium. A large group of students disregarded this request and ran down the hallway on the

west side near the gym and exited the building. They then ran out across Pierce, and then back to Clement Park. A few minutes later, some more students ran to the park from the school, and said "run, they are coming". They ran farther into the park, and then Jamie, Kristen, and Kristine Bell went to Bell's house.

Jamie didn't know Klebold, and only knew Harris from seeing him around school. She had said hello to Harris in the hallway, but that was the extent of it. She did not observe Klebold or Harris on either Monday or Tuesday. She really didn't know who was in the Trench Coat Mafia (TCM), but was warned the previous year in middle school to stay away from the TCM in Columbine High School. Jamie had seen TCM types around school, but did not know any of them.

Jamie Klement did remember something that caught her attention during the student morning news broadcast. The thought for the day stated something to the effect of "You'll wish that you weren't here today."

INVESTIGATION:

On 05-24-99, at about 1030 hours, I responded to 9147 West Cross Drive, Building 10, #102, to attempt to contact witness Brandy Klingbeil. Upon arrival at that location, I was advised that witness Brandy Klingbeil and her family no longer resided at that location. I went to the manager's office for this complex and was told the Klingbeil family had recently moved to 3194 South Dudley Street. I responded to 3194 South Dudley Street to contact and interview Brandy Klingbeil, who was a student at Columbine High School. This interview was in reference to the shooting that occurred on 4-20-99 at Columbine High School.

At approximately 1100 hours on 5-24-99, I contacted Brandy Klingbeil, who told me that neither her father, witness Doug

Klingbeil, or mother, witness Valerie Klingbeil, were currently at home. Brandy Klingbeil said she would not be able to contact them, but said they would allow me to interview her about this incident without them being present.

Brandy Klingbeil said on 4-20-99, at about 1150 hours (she believed, but was not certain of the time) she went into the cafeteria at Columbine High School and was carrying her backpack (which she described as a blue Jansport with her name on it). She said she selected a cafeteria table to sit at. On the diagram of the Columbine High School cafeteria, Brandy identified table "S" as the one she selected. Brandy said she sat at this table facing in a north easterly direction towards the stairway that leads to the second level of Columbine High School. Brandy said she was with Amber Rosetta, Matt Bruce, Matt Hill, and Ben Schuman. She also identified where these students were sitting at the table on the diagram.

Brandy Klingbeil said that Ben Schuman went to the Rebel Corner at the cafeteria, and when he returned to the table he said either he saw someone who had been shot or he saw someone get shot. Brandy Klingbeil said at this time a janitor told the students in the cafeteria to get down on the floor and underneath the tables. Brandy said the students at her table got under the tables and remained there for approximately one minute. Brandy said she heard other people screaming so she got up and ran up the stairway to the second level of Columbine High School with other students. When she got to the top of the stairs Brandy said she heard three shots that sounded to her like they were coming from the cafeteria downstairs. She said when she got to the top of the stairs she turned to the right, but did not go past the library, instead made a fast left turn and went down a hallway, then exited the school through the doors by the math classrooms. She said when she had turned right at the top of the stairs and then turned left quickly she did not notice anything unusual or hear anything unusual that she could recall in the area of the library. Brandy said once she exited the school, she ran across South Pierce Street and into Leawood Park. She said she was running with several other students and when one of these students said they were going to run to one of their houses in the Leawood area, Brandy said she asked if she could go along with them, even though she did not know who these students were. She said she was told she could go with them.

Brandy Klingbeil said on 4-20-99 she was wearing blue jean shorts and a Columbine High School warm up jacket for soccer. This jacket is blue with red and white stripes on the sleeves and has a Rebel insignia on the back of it.

I showed Brandy Klingbeil photographs of the duffle bags and the propane tank that were later recovered in the cafeteria. She said she did not recall seeing either of these items prior to or during the incident. She also said she does not know of anybody who may be manufacturing explosive devices and/or possess firearms. She said she will contact me if she hears of anything like this in the future.

Brandy Klingbeil said she does not know Dylan Kleboid or Eric Harris. She said she did not know any of the "Trench Coat Mafia" students or their names. Brandy said she knew of the "Trench Coat Mafia" and had seen them walking up the sidewalk at Columbine High School while she was at soccer practice. She believes she saw three of them walking together. She said she did not see anyone harassing the "Trench Coat Mafia" students, nor did she see the "Trench Coat Mafia" students harassing any other people.

Brandy Klingbeil said she did not know anybody with a double pierced eyebrow. She said she is aware that the Columbine High School Rebel News Network (RNN) has a thought of the day after the announcements in the mornings, however, she said she does not pay attention to them. She did not know what the thought of the day was on 4-20-99.

Brandy Klingbeil said she has been doing fine dealing with this incident since it occurred on 4-20-99, however, I left business cards for her and her parents and told her to contact me if any of them wanted to talk to a JCSO Victim Advocate in the future. I advised her I would make the necessary arrangements for them.

DISPOSITION: Case is open, pending further investigation.

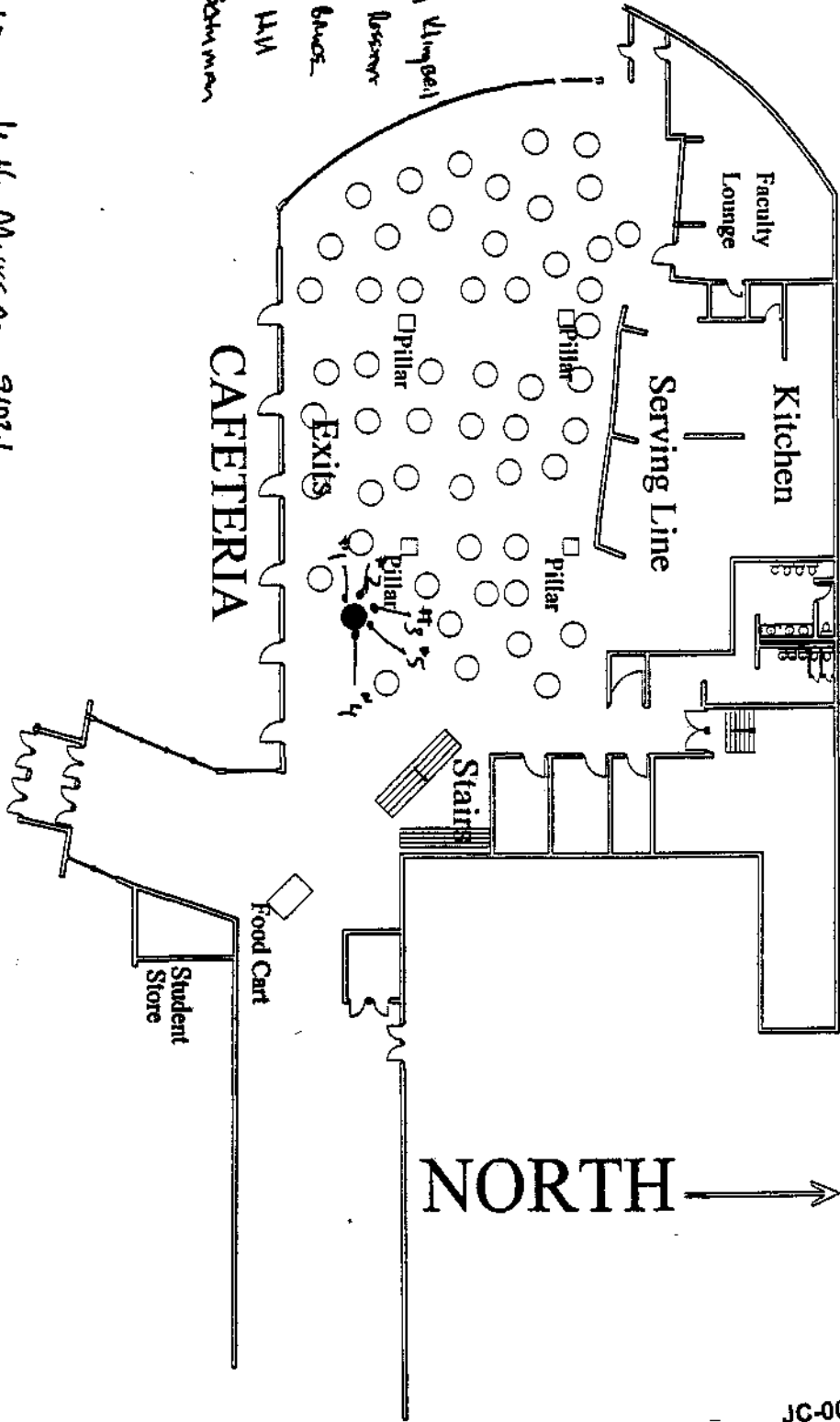

Lacy Koch, Dob: 05/02/83, 8210 West Calhoun Drive, Littleton, Colorado, was interviewed regarding her presence in the cafeteria during the shooting.

Koch was in the serving line getting lunch. She sat her tray down on a table. A little kid ran by her, yelling that there was a guy with a gun. She stated no one took him serious. Mr. Sanders and Mr. Kreidler then entered the cafeteria and yelled for everyone to get under tables. Koch then heard 6 or 7 pops from outside. She thought they sounded different than gunshots, but not explosions. She then heard louder shots in the cafeteria. She ran to the stairway which leads upstairs to the library and auditorium. She ran up the stairs, turned to the left, and ran to the East exit of the school. She then joined other students and teachers at Leewood park on the East side of Pierce Street.

During her time in the park she overheard rumors that there had been a bomb threat earlier in the morning. She said a group of teachers were in the park, near an ambulance. At one point she thought Mr. Moore, a black teacher, was being shot at from somewhere. She said Mr. Moore appeared to be moving around to dodge fire.

Koch did not see the suspects and could not provide any information on them. She only saw people falling down outside the cafeteria and stated she tripped on several people who were falling while running from the school.

Lacy explained that she arrived at Columbine High School on April 20, 1999, at about 0715 hours, attending her normally

scheduled classes. Lacy stated that fourth hour she has a math class taught by Mr. Bundy. After she was released from her fourth hour class at 1110 hours, she proceeded down into the cafeteria for lunch, arriving around 1113 hours. Lacy stated that she did not observe anything out of the ordinary while she was walking to the cafeteria area. Lacy was provided a map of the cafeteria area and asked if she could tell me which table she was seated at. Lacy stated she was seated at table T with her friends, Kristen Schoenhoff and Jennie Smith. Lacy stated after placing her green backpack on a chair at the table she proceeded to the rest rooms, which are located near the kitchen area or near the lower entry doors into the auditorium. After leaving the rest room, Lacy proceeded to the food service line, where she got her lunch. As Lacy turned and walked towards the condiment table, which is near the food service line, she stated that she recalled that an unidentified student, who she believes was a freshman, came running from the vending machines, which are near the northwest door of the cafeteria, and the student was yelling, "Oh my God, get down, there's somebody outside with a gun." Again, Lacy stated that she did not know who this individual was. She recalls that shortly after this person entered into the school she remembers seeing Mr. Sanders and Mr. Kritzer come out of the faculty lounge and they were also telling students to get under their table.

Lacy explained that she crouched down and that she remembers seeing her best friend, Sara Anderson, Tina Chavez, and Samantha Roman also crouched under the table, at which time she heard anywhere from six to seven gunshots, or as she described they sounded like firecrackers popping outside, and she could see people outside running in all different directions. As this occurred the students who were near the west side of the cafeteria started moving east and continued up the stairs to the main level in the school. Lacy advised that she followed the other students, heading out of the cafeteria, and remembers that once she reached the top of the stairs she remembers hearing gunshots and they were coming from the cafeteria area. Lacy explained there was a large group of students that had fallen in the hall, just to the east of the staircase, and that she had to maneuver around them. She continued east down the math/science hallway to the southeast exit of the school, where she ran from the school and went to Leawood Park. From Leawood Park, Lacy stated that she went to Josh Brinkley's house, but they were unable to get into his residence because he had forgotten his keys in the school, at which time they contacted one of Josh's neighbors and were allowed to stay for a brief period of time.

Lacy was asked while she was in the cafeteria area if she observed two large duffle bags or sports bags, one being blue in color, and the other being reddish/orange color. I explained to her that they were in the central core area of the cafeteria. Lacy could

not provide any information about the bags, telling me that she did not see them. Lacy was asked if she observed any gunmen while in Columbine High School or if she observed any gunmen after she had exited. She stated she did not.

Lacy was asked if there had been any rumors of something that was going to occur on April 20th. She stated that she knew April 20th was National weed or marijuana day, and she also explained that on the morning of April 20th she remembers hearing about a bomb threat.

Lacy was asked if she members of the Trench Coat Mafia, specifically Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold or any of their associates. She stated she didn't personally know any of them, and that she didn't know any of the associates, but she did mention that [REDACTED] was apparently on a hit list that Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold had. Lacy was asked to describe her dress on the day of the incident in question. She stated that she was wearing a long sleeve, green Gap shirt. Undemeath that shirt was a white tank top, black pants, and black sandals. Lacy described her backpack as being green in color and the brand name was "Nike."

A the completion of my interview I had Lacy diagram where she was seated within the cafeteria area and her movement through the cafeteria. A copy of that map is provided with this supplemental report.

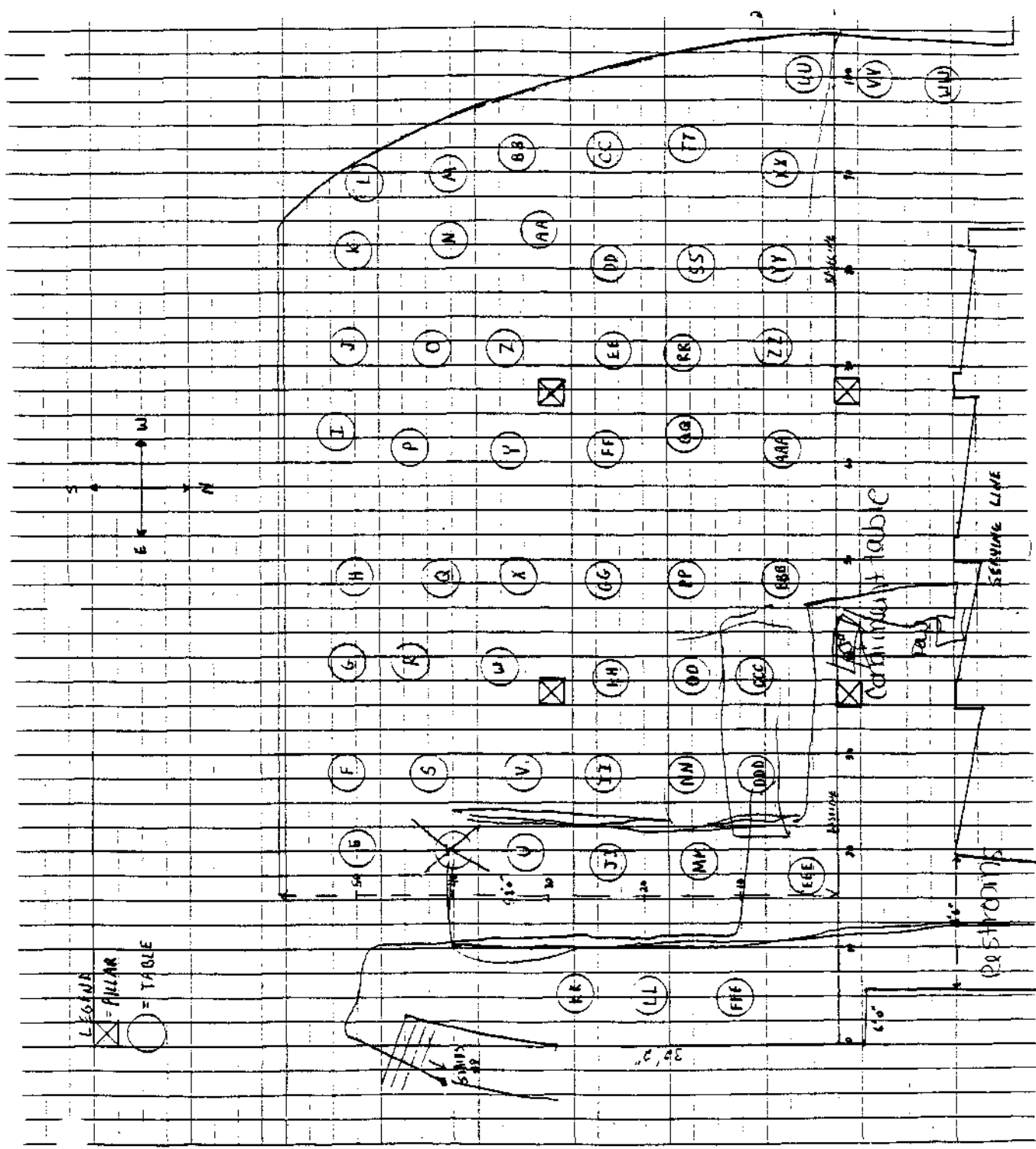



On 04-29-99 at 2:20 P.M. Denver Police Detective Terry Demmel, assigned with the Columbine Law Enforcement Task Force, interviewed Columbine High School teacher Eric Kritzer by phone. Det. Demmel asked Eric if he had Eric Harris in his 3rd hour Philosophy Class to which Mr. Kritzer answered "yes; he did". When asked if Harris was in class that day, Tuesday the 20th, Mr. Kritzer stated that he didn't believe so but that he could possibly have been. Det. Demmel told Mr. Kritzer that student Vanessa Grimes had been interviewed and reported that both Eric Harris and [REDACTED] had been in class with her that day and had discussed Chinese Philosophy. Mr. Kritzer did not think that [REDACTED] was in class that day either. He stated that the class did not have any discussions that day but instead had a written test on Chinese Philosophy. Mr. Kritzer added that the one sure way to tell if the boys had been in class that day was to check the folder of test papers that was in the room.

In asking Mr. Kritzer if Eric Harris had made any statements or given any indication of behavior out of the norm he answered that Harris was a good student and that he would have to check his grade book to see where Harris stood as far as his grade was concerned.

Mr. Harris advised to get in touch with his 3rd hour class student assistant, Rebecca Hines; that she may be able to give some additional information on Eric Harris.

On 04-30-99 Det. Demmel spoke with Jefferson County Sheriffs Office Columbine High School Scene Commander Chris Andres advising him of the information. A short time later Jefferson Co. Sheriffs Commander Andres called Det. Demmel back with the information that they had gone to Mr. Kritzers 3rd hour Philosophy room and found the folder of test papers. He stated that both Vanessa Grimes and [REDACTED] had taken the written test but that there was no test paper for Eric Harris.

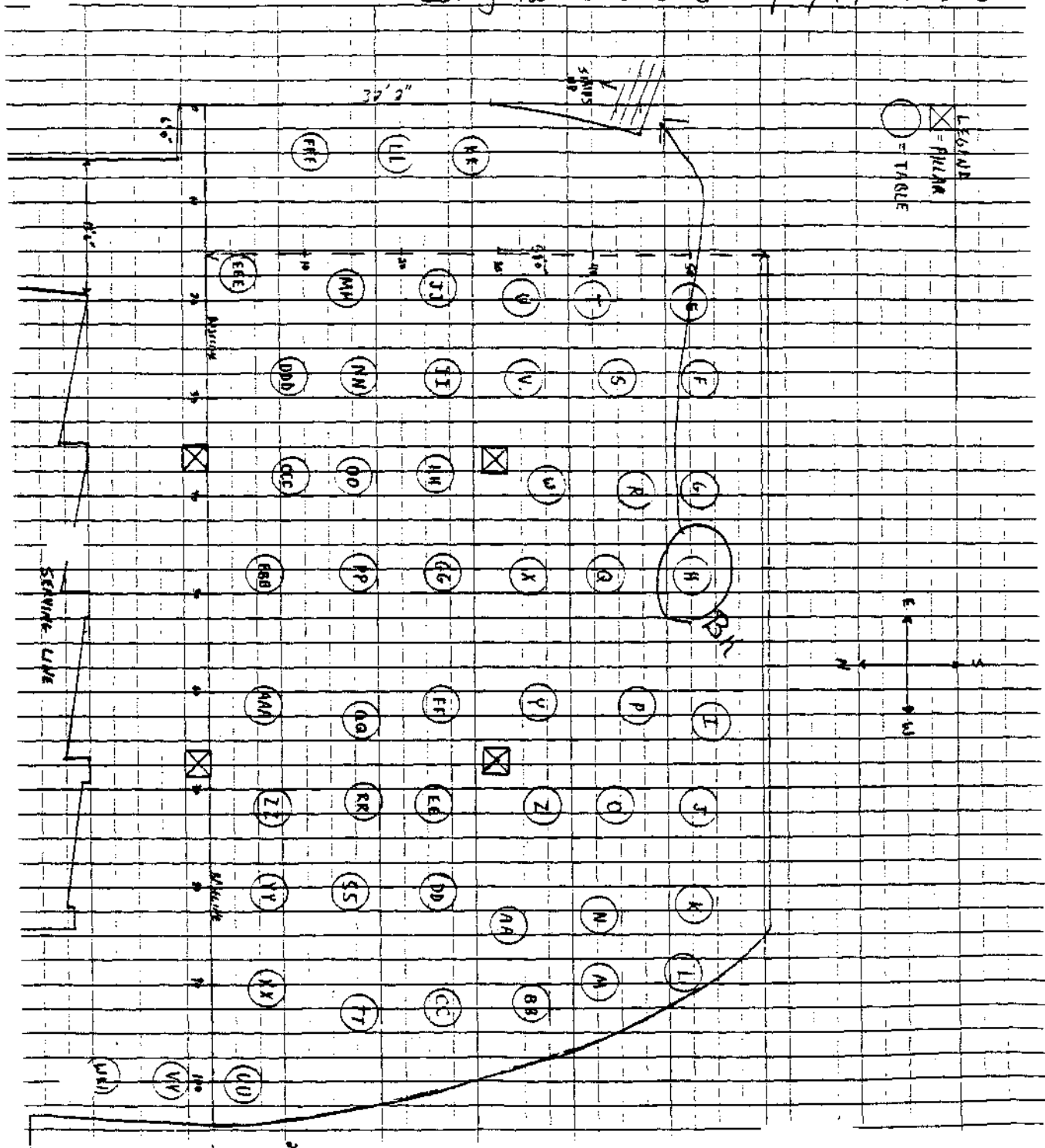

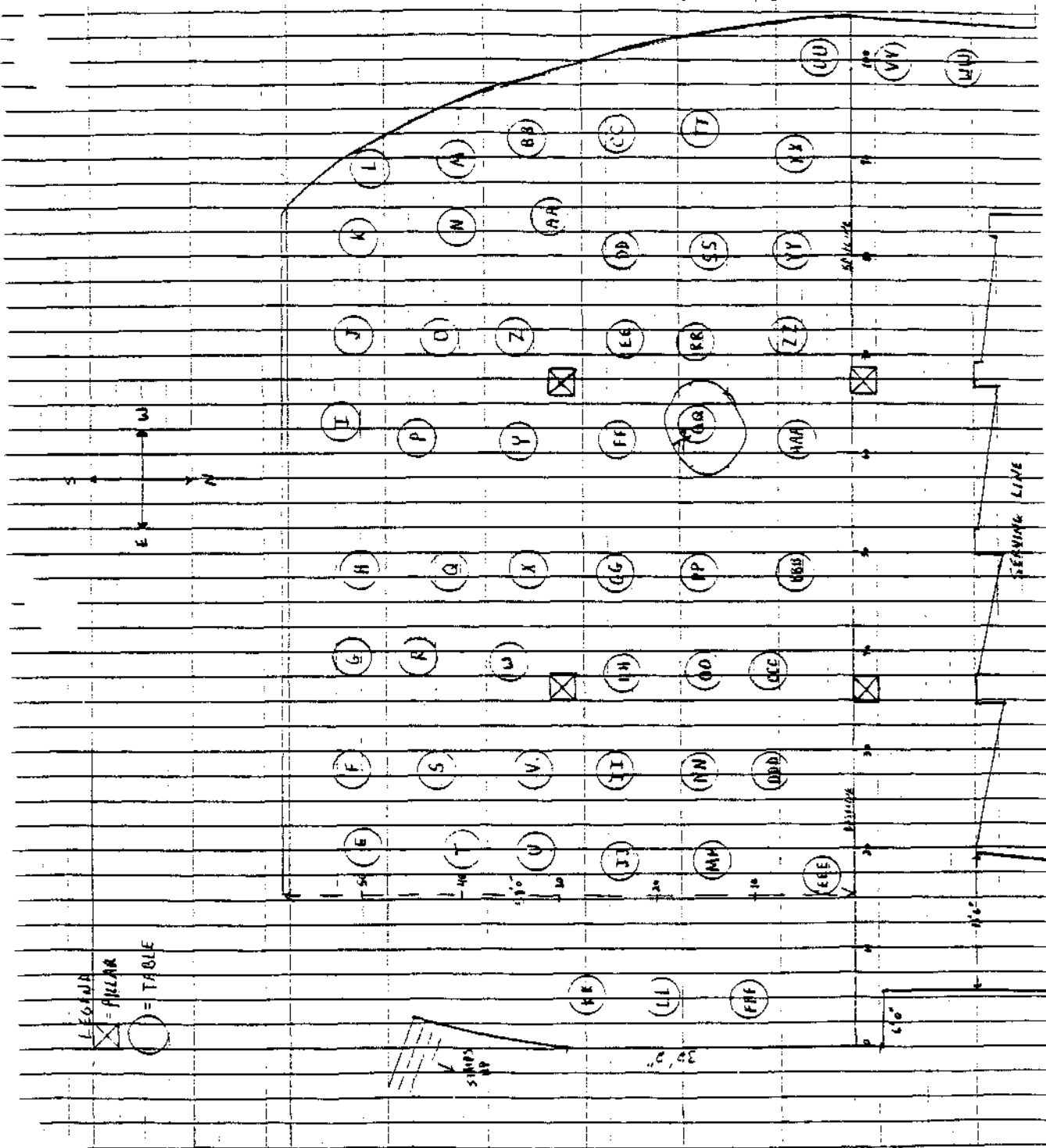
